Dan Ramos will be joining us to teach Jazz, Hip Hop and Contemporary on Fridays in West Harrison.



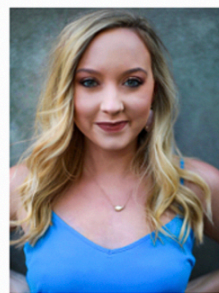
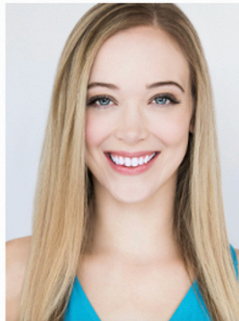
