

Roads Project Recap

- **2014/15**: Road improvement project reviewed Current road condition: Poor Engineered, estimated
- **2016**: Final petition circulated FAILED by 6 votes
- 2023/24: Road improvement project reconsidered
 Current road condition: Very Poor
 RCOC & Independence Twp. plans evaluated
 Voted to pursue RCOC plan
- **2025**: Final petition 3/3/25 6/2/25
- **2026**: Construction: Pending





And the results are...

RCOC requires **51%** approval per street. Independence Twp. requires 51%+ for the whole subdivision.

Entire Subdivision- 60.24%

Ridge Trail South - 50.88% 7 linear feet short!


Lost Hickory Court - 48.47% **39 linear feet short!**

PETITION WILL FAIL BY RCOC STANDARDS.

Corner Lots Assessment

Corner lots are assessed differently because 2 sides of the property are on a street: frontage and side lot.


PAVING FRONT LOT AND SIDE LOT

Main frontage is charged the standard SAD baseline rate. The cost may go up based on additional main frontage. Side lots (when combined with front lot) get a smaller benefit and lower cost.

• Based on this example, RCOC assigns approximately 10% increase above the main lot charge.

PAVING SIDE LOT ONLY

Side lots are assessed based on standard benefit formulas.







NAMES AND LOCATION OF STREET OR STREETS PETITIONED TO BE PAVED AND IMPROVED

RIDGE TRAIL, RIDGE TRAIL NORTH, and RIDGE TRAIL SOUTH (platted as RIDGE TRAIL SOUTH), platted in Independence Valley No. 2, Section 2, Independence Township, Oakland County, Michigan.

BIRCH GROVE LANE, platted in Independence Valley No. 3, Section 2, Independence Township, Oakland County, Michigan.

LOST HICKORY (dedicated as LOST HICKORY COURT), southeast of Ridge Trail South (platted in Independence Valley No. 2, Section 2, Independence Township, Oakland County, Michigan), dedicated to the Road Commission for Oakland County via parcel split and as part of the Independence Valley No. 2 plat, Section 2, Independence Township, Oakland County, Michigan. LOST HICKORY (dedicated as LOST HICKORY COURT) is bordered by the following parcels: #08-02-329-010, #08-02-328-010, #08-02-329-007, #08-02-329-008, #08-02-328-013, #08-02-328-012, and #08-02-328-011, located in Section 2, Independence Township, Oakland County, Michigan.
