




Mrs. Weddington's Yard

Our Book Markets in 2025

Took a look back at our four key markets over the past year: US, UK, CA and AU. From what I can see, when I take all the book formats into consideration, the US market wins out, primarily due to paperback sales, though US and UK went back and forth in ebook sales. Canada and Australia were not that far behind in ebook.

When focusing on the formats, ebook wins overall (kindle and KU subscription), with paperback not too far behind (boosted during the holidays). The large print paperback market was consistent but well behind "regular" paperback sales. Hardcover format, as


expected, was well behind the other formats, and was almost exclusively in US, I believe via third-party markets, though it's hard for me to track that down.
