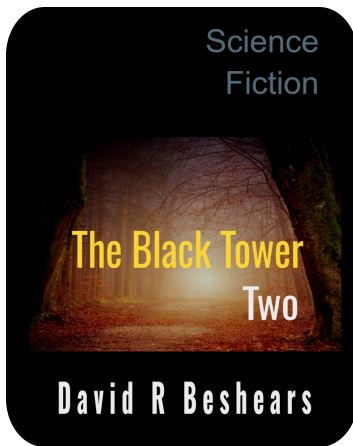

I made the move from the outline / plotline work over to actual writing a few weeks ago, really liking my time back in the Black Tower universe. There is still work to do with several of the plotlines, but the novel structure and main plotlines are completed and the details of the secondary storylines can be fleshed out as I go.

I'll have a better idea of the development calendar in another month or so, but I'm still seeing a tentative publishing date likely sometime in January.



Gordon's Porch Three Project

While I'll be focusing the vast majority of my literary development time for the next eight or nine months on the Black Tower sequel, I am hoping to set aside some time to work on Gordon's Porch Three, the final novella in the trilogy. There is no actual schedule as yet, but it would be great if the novella could publish sometime in late Fall. I do have a rough outline in place, and of course I know where the trilogy is going, but that's about it at this point.

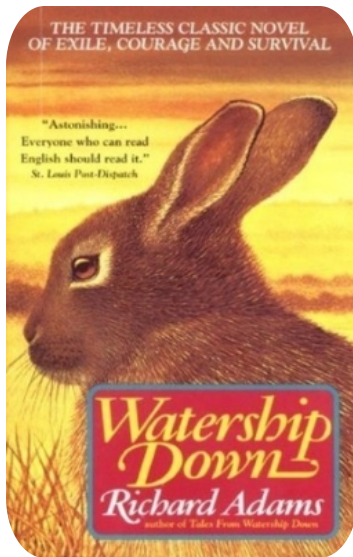


Last Day at Sharp Park Picks Up Award

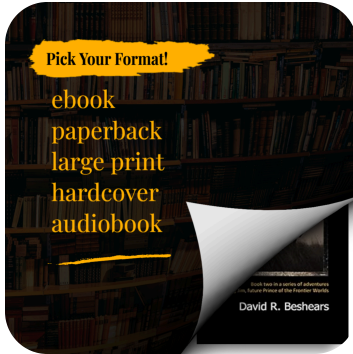
