GLCFI RETREAT

What is a Retreat?

A retreat is exactly what it sounds like - the chance to step aside from life for a while, to rest and just 'be' in a welcoming, peaceful place.

Who should do the retreat?

Retreats are for all members of the prayerline or church and people you choose to join with you. There are no expectations on anyone doing the retreat and you don't need to be a churchgoer.

Is a retreat right for me?

Do you:

- Wish for some quiet time with God?
- Want a weekend to Plan for your new year?
- Do you Long to know more about prayer?
- Need some time for reflection away from work or family?
- Want to deepen your spiritual life?

Then a retreat might be just for you.

What is an individual retreat

An individual retreat is a time when you can step aside from the busyness of life to be alone with God. There is no set programme, but Princess Glory can meet with you for up to an hour a day to listen to you and to God on your behalf and help you to make the most of your time.

Pay attention to entry into and leaving your retreat.

Allow yourself enough time to transition into the retreat. Maybe use the car ride to turn down the noise by driving without music or by silencing your phone. Sometimes my best conversations with Jesus are in the car, so I benefit from driving to a retreat location in the quiet.

Then, as you leave and head into whatever a regular routine looks like for you, make sure you close out your time well. It might not be a good idea to end a retreat on a Sunday night and head into work the next morning. However, you know what will be best with your routine and how you function.

Come expectant.

Regardless of your location, plan, and even transitions to and from retreat, be expectant. You'd better believe the Lord is excited to be with you.

“Therefore the Lord waits to be gracious to you, and therefore he exalts himself to show mercy to you. For the Lord is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for him (Isaiah 30:18).

Do I need to go to a retreat centre?

No- you can do it in your house, you can do it at night in your house, You can do it in your house. If you have the money to go away you can do so.

Do I need to fast during the retreat?

No – you need to spend time with God- no cooking or cleaning during the hours of the retreat. If you want to FAST feel free to do so. Make sure you have planned the food you will eat during the break.

Do I switch off my phone?

No – if you are using it for bible reading, for watching messages and watching the recommended films.

You must not talk to people during your retreat hours. You can do the chatting during your break or after 7 pm

Where the retreat is held matters.

One thing you can definitely expect from any Christian retreat is an opportunity to experience the stillness and solitude found in silence most often near nature. Retreats in quiet areas near woods, mountains and lakes help us reconnect with our creator. Going to a retreat in a beautiful place makes it easier to leave your stress behind and unplug.

What do you mean by residential retreats?

During residential retreats (doing retreat at home or special retreat centre), one is immersed in a full days of prayer and meditation, away from the outside world. They are a time for prayer, reflection, and renewal of life. It is a time to move from the daily routines of everyday life and journey in meditation of the Word of God to deepen one's relationship with God.

What I should wear?

Please dress modestly, as an expression of respect for God – as you when you go to a church. Wear Comfortable, loose clothes are best for sitting meditation. You'll need indoor shoes or slippers. DRESS LIKE YOU HAVE AN APPOINTMENT WITH A KING

Typically we start the day early with hot water and lemon to hydrate and cleanse the body

How long is the retreat ?

Minimum is 2 days

As we near the second coming of Christ, I find that God calls me to increase my retreats with Him. Let this annual 24-hour retreat whet your appetite for mini retreats of several hours, a half day, or an eight-hour day. Explore multiple day retreats as well. You may find that the Holy Spirit may impress you to spend this retreat in other ways than you have planned.

How many Hours is the retreat?

- 12 hours a day e.g 7am – 7pm= you take a 1 hour break for lunch (day1)
- **Total hours for retreat is 24 hours**
- You can break you into few hours if you can't do the 2 full days
E.G 4hrs every day for 6 days

HOW CAN YOU MAKE THIS RETREAT MEANINGFUL?

1. Be. Take time to just be. Slow down from your busy pace. This may take an hour or two. Let go of business and pressures. Make yourself available to God. Be still and know that He is God ([Ps. 46:10](#))

2. Thank. Sometimes the last to receive our thanksgiving is God. Vocalize the unspoken lists of things that He has done for you lately. Celebrate what He's presently doing in your life. Note the times over the past year that God has provided for you, blessed you, and encouraged you. You will find that in thanking Him, He will gently lift your thoughts to Him higher and still higher.

3. Praise. Spend time praising God for who He is. Tell Him what you love about His character. Voice to Him what makes you in awe of Him as your God and King.

4. Confess. Make things right with God. Surrender your attitude, desires, and heart to Him. You may need to make a call to someone you have wronged. Go into the rest of the retreat feeling at peace and restful in spirit.

Ask God to break open your heart to Him. Tell God your cynicism, criticism, lust, pride, and fears. Ask Him to give you a new heart by His Spirit.

5. Feed your mind. After confession, ask your heavenly Father to send the Holy Spirit to bring powerfully the Written Word of God to your heart. Spend time with the Bible. This is God's Word to you personally. Read His promises to you. Reflect on stories of Bible characters of great faith. Here are a few suggestions for promises and stories to study and reflect on in God's Word:

- [Ephesians 3:20](#); [Philippians 4:13, 19](#); [James 1:5](#); [2 Corinthians 9:6–11](#);
- Noah—fearless antediluvian prophet who took God at His word;
- Joseph—fierce loyalty to God in the midst of darkness and injustice;
- Job—faith during adversity and loss;
- Ruth—devotion, invested in relationships, love story;
- Nehemiah—building what others said could not be built;
- Esther—one who seized the day for God;
- Daniel—integrity, strategic influence for God’s purposes;
- Elijah—faced a showdown with God’s strength;
- Paul—bold pioneer for the good news of Christ;
- Philip—followed the Holy Spirit to “barren” places.

6. Dialogue. List your life roles (for example, a disciple of Christ, spouse, parent, son, daughter, grandparent, neighbour, friend, pastor, administrator, leader, coach, etc.). Concentrate on your top four to eight roles.

- Review your roles with God and what is happening in these roles right now.
- Ask God what you can celebrate in what you are currently doing in each role.
- Write down the good things that God helped you to accomplish in each role over the past year.
- Ask God what He thinks needs to change in each of your roles.
- Ask God which one or two things you need to do in each role to be faithful to what He has entrusted to you. God has vision for the roles He has entrusted to you, so ask Him.

7. Listen, plan, and reflect. Take breaks to reflect, listen, and pray. Jot down reflections on what God brings to your mind. Sleep on them. Spread out your reflections and convictions before God. Ask God, “This is what I am seeing—am I understanding what You want me to see?” Review and add to what you have. Let God’s wisdom on your life roles impact the way you accept or reject the opportunities before you. Will your life decisions help you be more or less faithful to the roles He has entrusted to you? Always test the insights you receive with the Written Word of God.

8. Claim God’s promises to accomplish His will.

9. Debrief. Find one of the prayer partners who prayed for you while you were on your retreat. Share how God blessed you. Share what God is asking of you in your life roles for the coming year. Invite honest feedback. Ask him or her to pray that you will follow through with God’s leading in your life.

If you are in doubt about any of the impressions you received during the retreat, invite your prayer partner to join you in testing your impressions with the Written Word of God.

WHAT TO DO DURING THE RETREAT

1. Spend Time in Prayer

One of the best ways that we can communicate with God is through our spoken prayers. We should always put God first in our day, it will impact the way we face each day. The earlier we wake up, the better. Time spend with God alone is well worth the time spend.

Always start off your prayer by thanking Him for being your heavenly Father and for everything that He has done in your life. Then, pray for your needs and for those of others that you know. Find the time and your secret place and meet with God daily. (Matthew 6:6) says “go to your secret place, pray and God will reward you”. God loves hearing from you. He said in (Jeremiah 33:3) call upon me and I shall answer you. Your prayer doesn't have to be long and complicated. It's really just you talking to God just like you would to your earthly father. Learn how to listen to God which is just as important. Record what God has spoken to you in your prayer journal. It is a must that you start a prayer journal. In it, don't just write your prayers. Write bible verses that speak to your heart, write prayer requests for others, write a praise poem, or whatever else you feel will connect you to God in worship. Use Philippians 4:8 to inspire your writing: “Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.”

2. Spend Time Reading the Bible

Read the Bible, which is God's Word written Word. Before you start, ask God to speak to you through its pages. Ask God for the revelation and a good understanding of what you are about to read. Memorize key bible verses as much as you can. Consider reading daily devotions for more understanding. Record what you have learned in your prayer journal.

3. Spend Quiet Time with God

Experience God's peace by seating quietly with Him. Ask God to speak to your heart and listen for the still quiet voice. Repeat God's promises to you as reminder that "he is actually not far from you (Acts 17:27).

4. Spend Time in Worship

God created us for worship. There is no right way or wrong way to worship God, as long as it is done to please Him. In John 4:23-24, Jesus said that we are to "worship the Father in spirit and truth." You cannot just go through the motions in worship; nor can you just put on a show to make yourself appear holy. But if your worship is centered in spirit and truth, you are doing it right. You can worship God in many different ways. It is a beautiful thing and a gift from God to be able to find Him in a familiar songs or prayers. I like to listen to the artistry of anointed gospel music. This creates a shift in my atmosphere and immediately threshes my spirit into the inner court with God.

5. Spend Time Fasting if you can till 12pm or the time you agreed with God

Fasting isn't merely an act of self-deprivation, but a spiritual discipline for seeking more of God's fullness.

Which means we should have a plan for what positive pursuit to undertake in the time it normally takes to eat. We spend a good portion of our day with food in front of us. One significant part of fasting is the time it creates for prayer and meditation on God's word or some act of love for others.

Before diving headlong into a fast, craft a simple plan. Connect it to your purpose for the fast. Each fast should have a specific spiritual purpose. Identify what that is and design a focus to replace the time you would have spent eating. Without a purpose and plan, it's not Christian fasting; it's just going hungry.

What Are the Benefits of Doing on a Retreat?

Organizing, promoting, and putting on a Christian retreat can be hard work (we won't sugar-coat it!). But the retreat benefits far outweigh the costs and will be realized long after the experience ends.

In working in ministry — and in the Christian retreat space, specifically — for decades, we've seen God do amazing work in believers as they engaged in retreats, including:

1. A closer walk with God

When you are immersed in focused Bible teaching, study, and reflection, the Holy Spirit will bring you closer to God. By omitting competition for your time, attention, and energy, pursuing God and His character becomes paramount while on retreat, which inevitably brings you closer to Him.

2. Closer relationships with others

Getting away with friends and family is important for your relationships. While on retreat with very few distractions, you're more available to engage with those you love and bond with them over shared experiences, which leads to greater intimacy and growth.

3. Learning more about yourself

It's easy to get caught up in our routines and the many hats we wear. In "everyday life," we may be Mom, Boss, Husband, Employee — or any number of other roles. While on retreat, we step outside others' expectations of us, and we can put away any definitions we've been clinging to that outline culture's demands. On retreat, we can explore our identity in Christ and our relationship with Him.

4. Greater clarity about God's call

Hearing from God is sometimes not easy in our busy, noisy world. A retreat, surrounded by quiet and intentional Bible study, is more conducive to building your relationship with God (as we say earlier). When you are closer to God, you know more about His character, His will, and you're more apt to desire those things that He desires. You can also hear from Him more clearly.

5. Appreciation for the beauty of God's creation

There's a reason most Christian retreat centers are located in beautiful, natural locales. God's creation is breath-taking, and spending time in nature can often lead one to praise their Creator: "The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands" (Psalm 19).

EXTRA INFORMATION FOR HEALTH

1. Limit sugary drinks- Sugary drinks like sodas, fruit juices, and sweetened teas. Healthier alternatives include: water unsweetened teas (Herbal Teas)

2. Eat nuts and seeds (Not too much because it blocks lungs)
3. Avoid ultra-processed foods-Ultra-processed foods (UPFs)e.g snack cakes, fast food, frozen meals, packaged cookies, chips, bread, white rice
4. Drink less coffee
5. Eat more fatty fish
6. Get enough sleep-6- 8 hrs sleep
7. Feed your gut bacteria eating fermented foods like yogurt and sauerkraut, taking probiotic supplements
8. Stay hydrated Drinking water 3- 4 litres water
9. Don't eat heavily charred meats limit your consumption of red and processed meats like lunch meats and bacon
10. Avoid bright lights before sleep
11. Take vitamin D, vitamin C & Vitamin B and Multivitamins daily
12. Eat plenty of fruits and vegetables
13. Eat adequate protein
14. Get moving Doing aerobic exercise, or cardio, is one of the best things you can do for your mental and physical health.
5. Don't smoke or use drugs, and only drink in moderation. Smoking, harmful use of drugs, and alcohol abuse can all seriously negatively affect your health.

HOW TO ANOINT YOUR HOME

Read Psalms 91

Through the blood of Jesus and *Psalm 91*, you are promised protection from every danger—sickness, disease, assault, crime, tornadoes, fire and any other threat to your safety and well-being. But God’s protection is not automatic. There are things you have to do in order for God to be your refuge.

And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.” –*Isaiah 10:27, NKJV*

Exodus 40:9 New International Reader's Version (NIRV)

“Get the anointing oil. Anoint the holy tent and everything in it. Set apart the holy tent and everything that belongs to it. Then it will be holy.”

Exodus 40:9 Common English Bible (CEB)

“Then take the anointing oil and anoint the dwelling and everything in it. Make holy the dwelling and all its equipment, and it will be holy.”

Ephesians 6:12 "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places."

One way to appropriate your faith for supernatural protection is to anoint your home with oil. Oil represents the power of the Holy Spirit and is a symbol of faith in God's ability to cleanse and make holy. It is an act of consecrating your home to Him.

All you need is some oil (olive, sesame, canola, etc). When you pray over or consecrate the oil, it is set apart and becomes anointing oil. Pray that God make that oil Holy and consecrate it as anointing oil.

After you have prayed over the oil, follow these steps:

1. Remove anything with evil roots from your home.

This can be books, movies, clothing with certain pictures or symbols, or objects that have a connection to wrong spirits.

2. Set the atmosphere to invite the Holy Spirit.

Play Worship music. Start to worship God. Pray aloud in every room. Invite the Holy Spirit to fill every inch of your home.

GLCFI RETREAT

Pray that only His will be done and that everything that is said and done in your home will be pleasing to Him. Plead the blood of Jesus over each room and your family. There is great power in the blood of the Lamb!

3. Get the family involved if possible.

4. Open up the main doors of your home.

5. As you do these things, place oil on the frame of every door and windows in your home.

Do this by faith, believing and receiving God's supernatural protection over your home and family, but do not anoint the main door yet.

Pray this prayer:

"Jesus, by faith I anoint this home, windows and doorways and declare them all holy unto you and ask that You would cleanse this home of every unclean spirit and human spirit that does not belong here. I rebuke the power of darkness and any attempt of the enemy against my home and my family. In the name of Jesus, Satan, I bind you, I bind you hindering spirits, I bind you spirits of the prince of the air, I bind you evil forces, I command you to take your hands off of our spirits, souls, bodies, hearts, minds, emotions, and material things, off of my children, the cats, the dogs and this home. I bind your mouth and your power and command you, in the Name of Jesus, that every evil spirit in this house leave through this unanointed door, FOREVER, and EVER, AMEN!

6. Anoint the frame of the last door and close it, then

Pray this prayer:

LORD we sanctify and seal our home and invite Your presence to dwell in our home FOREVER, and EVER, AMEN!

7. Lastly, anoint your spouse and children.

Pray this prayer:

"Jesus, by faith I anoint me, my spouse, and my children. Jesus, I pray for the anointing of your blood, the surrounding and a hedge of protection of Your mighty warrior angels and the overshadowing power and protection of Your Holy Spirit over me, my spouse, the children, and ask that You would protect us from any attack of the enemy whether in spiritual or physical form, in Your name, Jesus, amen."

If you feel the need to re-anoint your home occasionally, you will only need to open the main door, command the evil spirits to leave, anoint the door again and ask the LORD to seal your home, inviting His presence back in your home.

Prayer for the retreat

Prayer Points For Favor.

Favor is divine preference, it is when you are preferred, promoted and considered above others.

In Christ, God has graciously favoured you, preferring you above all else even above angels and all heavenly beings.

GLCFI RETREAT

That is also true on earth; God's favour still puts some persons above others, giving them the advantage.

Yes, in your work, office, school, business, you need the favour of God to give you preference above your colleagues, mates, associates and competitors.

You need the hand of God, mercy and favour to distinguish you and give you the advantage. Yes God's favour gives you the advantage.

Prayer Points For Favor.

The following are prayer points for Favor that you can pray right away to permanently secure God's hand of mercy and favour over you, family, church and ministry, giving you the advantage:

1. Pray and ask the Lord to give you favour Like He did Joseph even while in prison, in Jesus name.

But while Joseph was there in the prison, the Lord was with him; he showed him kindness and granted him favour in the eyes of the prison warden. (Genesis 39:20-21, NIV)

2. Pray and ask the Lord to give you favour in your present place of work and service such that you will not leave the place empty with nothing to show for the years and time you spent there, in Jesus name.

And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them such things as they required. And they spoiled the Egyptians. (Exodus 12:36, KJV)

GLCFI RETREAT

3. Pray and ask the Lord to give you life through His favour, so your life can be preserved, in Jesus name

Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit. (Job 10:12, KJV)

4. Pray and ask the Lord to bless, shield and defend you with His hand of mercy and favour in your work and endeavours, before your employers and superiors, in Jesus name.

For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield. (Psalm 5:12, KJV)

5. Pray and ask the Lord to make you strong and cause all your endeavours to stand and remain strong through favour, in Jesus name.

LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, and I was troubled. (Psalm 30:7, KJV)

6. Pray and ask the Lord to prosper and look upon you in His mercy and favour, in Jesus name.

For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them. (Psalm 44:3, KJV)

7. Pray and say; Oh God, lift my head by your mercy and favour, in Jesus name.

For thou art the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted. (Psalm 89:17, KJV)

GLCFI RETREAT

8. Pray and ask the Lord to arise and show you mercy in his grace and favour, in Jesus name

Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come. (Psalm 102:13, KJV)

9. Pray and ask the Lord to remember you in His mercy and favour and visit you with His salvation, in Jesus name

Remember me, O LORD, with the favour that thou bearest unto thy people: O visit me with thy salvation; That I may see the good of thy chosen, that I may rejoice in the gladness of thy nation, that I may glory with thine inheritance. (Psalm 106:4-5, KJV)

10. Pray and ask the Lord with the whole of your heart to grace you with divine favour and don't stop asking until you obtain it, in Jesus name

I intreated thy favour with my whole heart: be merciful unto me according to thy word. (Psalm 119:58, KJV)

11. Pray and ask the Lord to grant you good understanding that makes room for favour, in Jesus name

Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of transgressors is hard. (Proverbs 13:15, KJV)

12. Pray and ask the Lord to have mercy upon you by His favour, in Jesus name.

And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee. (Isaiah 60:10, KJV)

GLCFI RETREAT

13. Pray and ask the Lord to bring you into favour and tender love with your boss, superiors, supervisors, teachers, lecturers and your dean of college, in Jesus name.

Now God had brought Daniel into favour and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs. (Daniel 1:9, KJV)

14. Pray and ask the Lord to visit you with the good news of divine favor like He did Mary the mother of Jesus, in Jesus name.

And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. (Luke 1:30, KJV)

15. Pray and ask the Lord to give you special favour with Himself and with people everywhere you go, live, work and play, in Jesus name.

And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man. (Luke 2:52, KJV)

16. Pray and ask the Lord to give you divine favour and connection with the high and the mighty in your state and nation, in Jesus name.

And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favour and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house. (Acts 7:10, KJV)

17. Pray and ask the Lord to decorate your life and adorn your neck with favour, such that everywhere you go and everywhere you turn, you will always be greeted with favour from people and with circumstances, in Jesus name.

GLCFI RETREAT

And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight. (1 Samuel 16:22, KJV)

Now, go ahead and thank the Lord for answers to your prayer for divine favour, in Jesus name.

Prayer Points for Grace

The following are prayer points for grace you can pray right away to activate God's free gift of grace in your life, family, church and ministry:

1. Pray and say; Father, thank you for the free gift of grace you have given me in the beloved, I believe I am graced, empowered and enabled to function with ease in my area of calling, in Jesus name.

But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. (Ephesians 4:7, KJV)

2. Pray and say; Father, help me find my place of calling, purpose and assignment in the kingdom, where your grace is waiting to fully and freely operate through me, in Jesus name.

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. (Jeremiah 29:11, NIV)

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen. (Philemon 1:25, KJV)

12. Pray and declare that you are abounding in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ, in Jesus name.

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord. (1 Corinthians 15:58, KJV)

GLCFI RETREAT

13. Pray and declare that grace and peace are being multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord. (2 Peter 1:2, KJV)

14. Pray and declare that God is making all grace to abound towards you in all things so much that you are becoming self sufficient in all things, in Jesus name.

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:8, KJV)

15. Pray and declare that God's grace is enough for you, and that His strength is perfected even in your weakness, in Jesus name.

And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. (2 Corinthians 12:9, KJV)

16. Pray and declare that you are growing in grace by all means, through the knowledge of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ, in Jesus name.

But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen. (2 Peter 3:18, KJV)

17. Pray and ask the Lord to help you take full advantage of the grace He has freely given you in Christ, in Jesus name.

Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 2:1, KJV)

Prayer Points For Church Growth And Revival

The following are prayer points for church growth and revival for you to pray:

1. Pray and say; Oh Lord God of heavens and the earth, maker of everything, revive your work on earth through the church, in Jesus name.

“Lord, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, Lord. Repeat them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy.” (Habakkuk 3:2, NIV)
