The safety and wellbeing of all riders and horses is of paramount importance, particularly in an event of this size. We would appreciate your co-operation in the following:

Please refrain from liquor or drugs while on the ride.

Rifles and off road vehicles are not permitted.

No dogs allowed in picnic area or on trails. Dogs must be tied up at all times.

Please refrain from horseplay on the trails (switching other horses, galloping by other riders, etc.).

No leaving the marked trails.

Proper footwear should be worn.

An adult ON AND OFF the ride must accompany children under 14.

The minimum age for any horse entering the ride is (3) years of age and in **good** condition.

While we appreciate some individuals may feel confident in their ability to manage and control a **stallion**; we reserve the right to request that a stallion be withdrawn at any *point* during the ride due to poor manners. **We also require that placing a red ribbon in its tail identify stallions and kickers. Also, all stallions must be double tied.**

Horses, feed and, transportation are the responsibility of the riders. Water will be available - please bring your own pail and tie your horses to your trailer or the hitching rails. Do not tie horses to the trees.

You are responsible for cleaning up your camp!

We wish to thank all of this year's participants for your support in making this year's Trail Ride Against Cancer a success. Your Cooperation in adhering to these rules will make our jobs a lot easier. We hope that you will join us and enjoy the day.
