Please keep horses out of flagged area.

To qualify, a rider must have sponsors who make a specific financial contribution to the Drayton Valley Health Foundation.

A MINIMUM of \$15 total donations for riders **14 years and under** and a **MINIMUM** \$25 for **all other riders** is **REQUIRED**.

Coffee, hot-chocolate, doughnuts and muffins will be served at 8 AM.

Lunch will be served at 12 noon with presentation of prizes.

Prizes will be awarded for the individual top earner (Based on the money collected and turned in on the day of the ride.)

Lunch will be available for purchase for riders and non-riders.

The safety and well-being of all horses and riders is of paramount importance, particularly in an event of this size we would appreciate your cooperation in the following:

- Please refrain from liquor or drugs while on the ride.
- Rifles and off-road vehicles are not permitted.
- No dogs allowed in picnic area or on the trails. Dogs must be tied up at all times.
- Please refrain from horse play on the trails(Switching other horses, galloping by other riders, etc.
- No leaving the marked trails.
- Proper footwear should be worn.
- An adult on and off the ride must accompany children under 14.
- The minimum age for any horse entering the ride is three years of age and in good condition.
- Stallions are not encouraged.
- Horses, feed and transportation are the responsibility of the riders. Water will be available –
 please bring your own pail entire horses to your trailer or the hitching rails do not tie horses to
 the trees.
- You are responsible for cleaning up your camp!
- Any E-transfer Pledges need to specify that they are for the cancer ride
- Participants must be present to receive prizes or the will be given to the next eligible Rider.

We wish to thank all of this years participants for your support and making this years Trail Ride against cancer a success. Your cooperation in adhering to the rules will make our jobs a lot easier. We hope that you will join us and enjoy the day.
