

Genesis 5:1-5 Here the Holy Spirit differentiates the use of the word "day". Instead of saying, "And the evening" (16)

- and the morning were Day one", He says "in the day", This can easily be translated as "during the time" or "in the time" and as such does not point to a literal 24 hour period. Here the Scripture says Seth was born when Adam was 130 years old, that he was born in Adam's image (not like Adam who was created in God's' image(s)). As we had noticed last week, indeed Adam and Eve had many, many, many children (20?, 30?, 40?, 50?, 60?). Scripture reaffirms what we are told about the Millennial period where people will once again live in a paradise like setting, "a person who is taken out at 100 years old is but a child", and that vitality will extend to hundreds of years. Also, Adam lived 930 years.

Genesis 5: 6-32 (Remember all these people about to be mentioned had many, many, many, boys and girls but we are only told about the lineages that matter. The lineages that would lead to Christ or that would lead to evil rulers. Seth (912 years), Enosh ($90 + 815 = 905$ years), Cainan ($70 + 840 = 910$ years), Mahalalel ($65 + 830 = 895$ years), Jared ($162 + 800 = 962$ years), Enoch (this is the Godly one like we noted last week when we read that, "Cain knew his wife, and she conceived and bore Enoch") ($65 + 300 + [300 \text{ B.C.} \rightarrow 2025 \text{ (and counting)}] \approx 5,032$ years).

"Enoch walked with God, and he was not, for God took him."
Note: Enoch has never tasted death, nor did Elijah.

Methuselah ($187 + 782 = 969$ years), Lamech ($182 + 595 = 777$ years)

Verse 29: "And he called his name Noah, saying, "This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands (our ministry??), because of the ground which the LORD has cursed". I believe that the Holy Spirit, God, or the pre-incarnate Lord Jesus prophesied to Lamech that Noah would provide a safe haven for the righteous in the time that God would curse the ground and pour out His wrath.

Noah: 500 years old and begot Shem, Ham, Japheth.
(Look at Bible timeline Adam $\rightarrow$ Moses.)

Genesis 6:1-4: The Nephilim verses: The Bible tells us that the

"sons of God" cohabitated with "the daughters of men" and that their offspring were "Giants" and "mighty men". Here are what theologians offer AS A POSSIBILITY: ① The law of first mention would suggest that these were fallen angels. Here in 6:2 + 6:4 are the first mentions. Then I researched where else "sons of God" appeared after that to get a definition, or meaning, of the term, Job 1:6, 2:1, 38:1-7 (specifically 7) would suggest them to be angels (fallen) - See printout. BUT THIS WOULD SUGGEST THAT ANGELS CAN MINGLE WITH HUMANS, WHEREAS THEY CAN NOT. God created Eve from Adam's rib (side, opening, cavity) and angels can not reproduce! ② That they are Godly human men (descendants of Seth) and the "daughters of men" as the ungodly line of Ham which would lead to the Philistines. We know for a fact that the Philistines had giants of 9 plus foot tall. Fully human. ③ That the term sons of God refers to kings or rulers who claimed divine status. The term "took wives" means that the powerful men took multiple wives for their harems, leading to a multiplication of sin. Giants in sin. Mighty men of sin. Old men of sin. ④ My opinion: The Bible does not tell us and that means IT IS NOT IMPORTANT. Furthermore, since the Bible does not tell us it is blasphemous to conclude something that God did not conclude for us. Conclusion: The liason between the "sons of God" and the "daughters of men" resulted in large giant like offspring. Evil offspring to be sure.

Also, in verse 3 we read, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever" (the Holy Spirit is only present right now to point us to Jesus. One day we will be with the Father, the Son our Lord, and the Holy Spirit. Hence He will not strive with man.). It also says, "yet his (mans) days shall be one hundred and twenty years". After looking at the Bible timeline on my wall (and also in the Sunday morning Bible study room) seems descendants lived:

Shem (600 years), Arphaxad (438 years), Selah (433 years) 18
- Eber (464 years), Peleg (239 years), Rue (239 years),
- Serug (230 years), Nahor (148 years), Terah (205 years),
Abraham (175 years) and so on. So, I discounted this as
being the life span of men. But, on the same Bible study
time line chart, Shem, Ham, and Japeth were all around
120 years old when mans days were numbered; "yet his
days shall be 120 years."

Genesis 6:5-8 God's heart is broken because of the continually
evil hearts of men; "Lord was sorry", "He was grieved", "He was
sorry that He made them". (Exactly like today 11/6/2025).

Genesis 6:9-22 Noah finds grace in God's eyes. Noah
lived a life of trying to walk in God. So God used Noah to
build an Ark large enough to repopulate the earth after the flood.

Genesis 7:1 God calls on Noah to come in to the ark. Why?
Because the Lord Himself was in the Ark. Whether the Ark
was made of Balsa wood or Titanium it would have never
withstood the Billions of Metric tons of water that came
crushing down when the canopy of water that was in the atmosphere
came crashing down. But, just like in our case when someone
is in the presence, clothed with Christ, God's wrath will
not ever reach them! The ark could have been made of
rice paper and it would have been a safe and smooth
journey. Intriguingly enough the Hebrew word "pitch",
Kaphar is both a bonding agent and also can be used
as "atonement". How fitting!

Genesis 7:2-24 God wipes out fallen mankind.

Genesis 8:1 Then God "remembered" Noah and all the
animals" does not mean that God forgot them. No, it means
that "the time had come"

Genesis 8:2-14 The flood is over. Noah and inhabitants land safely.

Genesis 8:15-19 God tells Noah it is safe to disembark
- and to set the animals free. God instills in the animals
to "abound on the earth, and be fruitful and multiply"
(We don't read it yet, but God also reprograms the animals

So that some become carnivores. This, and the upcoming ice age from the drastic weather and seasons change resulting in warmer winters and cooler summers led to massive Ice build ups on both poles of the planet, would probably combine to the extinction of the dinosaur species.

Genesis 8:20 After worship is instituted, I believe this is the first time in Scripture where "alter" and "burnt offerings" come about to be.

Genesis 8:21 The first covenant in the Bible was the Adamic covenant: Between God and Adam. God gives Adam dominion over the earth and animals, and for him to be fruitful and multiply. He also tells him not to eat of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Adam broke the covenant. The second covenant is here, The Noahic Covenant: That Noah is to be fruitful and multiply and He promises to never again destroy the earth as He has done (by Flood). He also describes life on this side of the flood.

Genesis 8:22 From then on till the end of the Tribulation (I believe, and not till the end of the Millennium is my assumption only) there will be seasons for planting. No more year round crops. Cold and heat will be introduced and thus winter and summer. And day and night will not cease to exist (regardless of what the climate alarmists say)!

Genesis 9:1-7 God gives Noah (and the animals) the appetite and permission to also eat meat. But not to partake of the blood because "the life" is in the blood. (This is why Satan's rituals always include blasphemous blood rituals). He also commands Noah not to shed blood (unnecessarily) and that the violation of doing so will result in the perpetrators blood being shed.

Genesis 9:8-14 God concludes the Covenant by binding it with Noah, his descendants and all of the creatures that roam the earth. And He seals it by implementing a rainbow when it rains, so that every one will remember His Promise. His covenant.
