As a No Wrong Door partner, the Aging and Disability Resource Centers (ADRC) provides information, support and referrals

to individuals of all ages, income levels and abilities. ADRCs also administer programs and services such as Information and Referral Services, Person-Centered Counseling (Options Counseling), Family Caregiver Support Program (FCSP), State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP), and Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP).

ADRCs are a collaborative effort of the Administration on Community Living (ACL) and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). ADRCs serve as single points of entry into the long-term supports and services system for adults who are aging & individuals with disabilities.

Specializing in assisting the above individuals with getting the support & resources needed to maintain their independence and ensuring that all populations regardless of payment sources has access to needed services.

ADRC Options Counseling staff have specialized training to guide individuals through the Medicaid application process.


