March has been filled with exciting opportunities to represent and serve my community as Miss Abdallah Rodeo. From

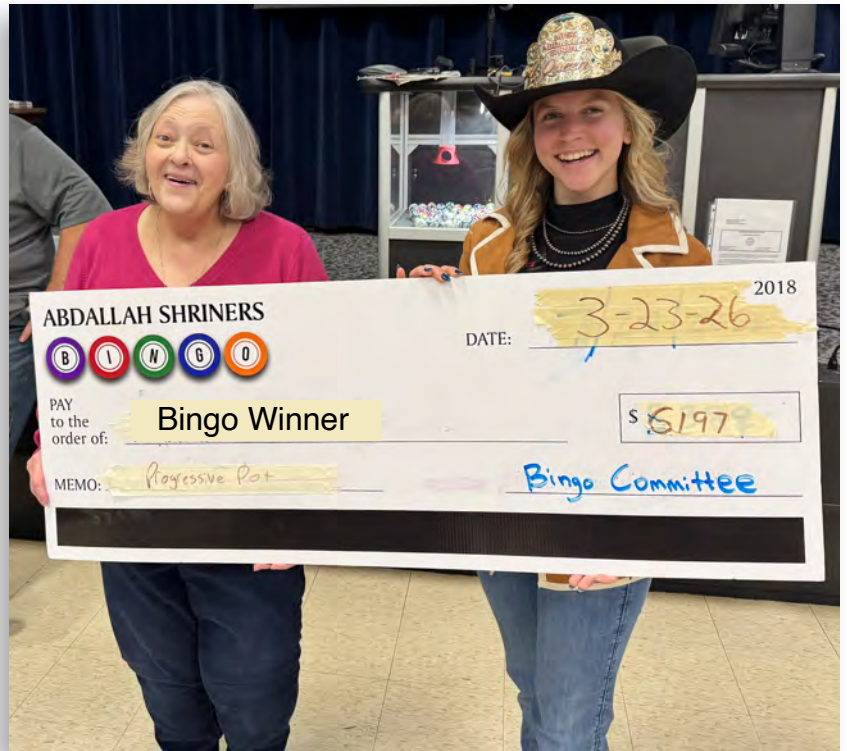
attending meaningful celebrations to volunteering at local events, this month has allowed me to connect with others and give back.

Kansas Shrine Duals...A Takedown Success!
