More Than Brothers...

Recently, two of our Nobles, Don Marah and Calvin Smith, made a connection that goes beyond brotherhood; they're now a part of each other...literally. Last month, Don received a life-saving kidney transplant from Calvin.

Over the last year, Don had been suffering from kidney failure and was getting close to the point of needing a transplant. Calvin had heard about Don's situation in a conversation with fellow Nobles at Abdallah. This hit home with him in particular because he had a close friend that had passed away from kidney failure before he could ever receive a transplant. Likewise, Calvin had other experiences and posted on social media *"...I have seen what kidney disease can do to someone. Being in the Medicare field, talking with folks on dialysis, and having other people I know go through it, that is not living. It's rough on everything from physical, mental, financial..."*

Last November, the two got together at Birthday Friday and talked about Don's situation and what could be done about it. Coincidentally, Don happened to know the mother of Calvin's friend that had passed away. It certainly seems like fate was brining these two together. As Don's condition worsened, testing began for Calvin in February to see if he would be a compatible donor. Miraculously, out of 153 markers used to identify a compatible donor, Calvin matched 149 of them. Don's doctors told him they've never seen that close of a match before, even with family members as potential donors.



The surgery took place on Thursday, July 16th at Saint Luke's Hospital on the Plaza. All went well and both Nobles are recovering. Don was even able to come out and watch Abdallah parade at the Leavenworth County Fair Parade on July 28th.

We look forward to seeing our two brothers in the future. Please keep them and their families in your prayers.
