

### Message from Your Chief Rabban

Today my message to the Nobility is of a concerning matter; per capita dues increase proposal from Shriners International.

At last years Imperial Session, it was proposed to increase per-capita dues for Shriners International by \$20 annually. This proposal in 2021 was defeated by the narrowest of margins. Due to Covid 19, Canadian Shrine nobility were not allowed to cross the US border to attend Imperial Session in Houston. We have been told they likely would have voted in favor of this proposal; it would have passed. This matters little to Abdallah Shrine, but it highlights the pathway we are headed in 2022.

Currently, Abdallah annual dues are \$80 for the temple, \$30 for Shriners International and \$5 of your dues are to support Shriners Children.

We duly expect a new proposal during the 2022 Imperial Session in Minneapolis to again propose a \$20 rate increase.

Shriners International serves our fraternity by providing a leadership organization supporting the approximate 200 Shrines around the world. As you may be aware SI has recently redesigned and consolidated the Shriners web presence to support improved membership activities and candidate tracking as well as promoting Shrine Bowl, Charleston Classic, Shriners Annual Golf Tournament and Shriners motor sports. SI produces an extremely popular quarterly magazine. SI supports the various regional Shrine associations like our own Central States Shrine Association.

Since 2012 Shriners International has cut overall expenses by \$500k. SI could save an additional \$200k per year by eliminating the Shriner's Magazine. This magazine is highly popular with our older Shriners as for many this is the primary communication with current Shrine activities. Shriners International have cut travel expenses by implementing virtual meetings. This has saved over \$100k per year.

All this support requires an employed staff. The costs associated with maintaining a staff is increasing. As many of you are aware, healthcare costs alone have surged. Most staff have not had even a minor pay increase. The existing staff are high skilled and most support SI technology services, a job category that is very much in demand these days.

Last year Imperial delegates passed a budget with the \$1.2M deficit. If this occurs for 5 more years, we will not last.

The biggest impact on Shriners International is something we at Abdallah know all too well... membership declines. Shriners international is receiving \$300k less per year due to declines in membership. Shriners around the world now number less that 200,000.

As your Chief Rabban, it is my duty and honor to represent all Abdallah Nobles and their long-term interest. It is due to the above reasons but mostly to the long-term viability of our Shrine, I support this Shriners International proposal

Personally, I encourage and recommend each Noble to purchase life-time memberships, including a Shriners International per-capita lifetime membership. This would protect you from this or future per-capita increases. Should this proposal pass as it is expected, we expect Nobles will have until Dec. 31, 2022 to purchase this life-time membership.

I expect some Nobles will disagree with this position, but I welcome your discussion, comments or opinions. My promise is to be honest, forthcoming, and proactive during my tenure on Abdallah's divan. My hope is that you accept my position in good faith. Regardless of the outcome to these difficult decisions, I respect each individual Noble's opinion and each will continue to be a brother Mason and friend to me.

# Shriners Hospitals for Children: A History of Innovation and Excellence in Burn Care

Shriners Hospitals for Children® is noted worldwide as a leader in pediatric burn care. Since opening our three pediatric burn hospitals in the 1960s, our health care system has been at the forefront of innovative programs and treatment techniques that have both dramatically improved the survival rate for children with severe burns and enhanced their quality of life. Here is a brief look at our work over the decades:

#### 19605

The governing body of the Shriners organization passed a resolution at the Imperial Session in 1962 to build and operate hospitals specializing in pediatric burn care. The first hospital opened in 1962 in Galveston, Texas, followed by additional specialized hospitals in Cincinnati, Ohio, and Boston, Massachusetts two years later.

#### 19705

Tremendous improvements in survival rates were made, particularly because of innovative research in excision, grafting and intravenous feeding. In addition, pressure garments that helped lessen scarring were developed. Shriners Hospitals for Children — Cincinnati pioneered skin banking – a precursor to future methods of tissue, bone and skin procurement. In addition, Shriners Hospitals for Children worked with the United States Fire Administration and Consumer Product Safety Commission to identify burn prevention programs for schools and fire departments. And, our Boston hospital began the first school re-entry program.

#### 19805

Outpatient clinics were added to provide continued care for patients after they have been discharged from the hospital. Also, researchers at Shriners Hospitals for Children discovered that early surgical excision and grafting reduces infections, shortens hospital stays and improves cosmetic outcomes for patients. Finally, Burn Awareness Week, a national education campaign, was created in an effort to raise public awareness and reduce the number of burn injuries in children.

#### 1990s

Care was made available for non-burn conditions such as port wine stains, congenital ear deformities and other complex wound and skin conditions. In addition, new programs were set up to help burn patients with psychological and social issues, including transitioning back to school and community. In 1996, Shriners Hospitals for Children — Boston collaborated with the American Burn Association to develop an outcome



instrument to measure functional outcomes in pediatric burn survivors. And, in 1997, Shriners Hospitals for Children — Northern California opened in Sacramento and soon became the busiest pediatric burn center in the Western U.S.

#### 2000s

The hospitals in Boston and Cincinnati received the Press Ganey Summit Award for extraordinary patient satisfaction. All four of the hospitals were recognized as leaders in the field of burn care, with each hospital maintaining a leadership position with the American Burn Association. Shriners Hospitals for Children — Boston, through microfluidics research, developed a micro-chip device that aids therapeutic strategies for burn patients.

#### 20105

In 2011, Shriners Hospitals for Children — Northern California hosted its first Regional Burn Conference, a continuing education program for physicians, nurses, first responders, therapists and other health care professionals. In 2014, David Herndon, M.D., Shriners Hospitals for Children - Galveston chief of staff, was awarded the Medallion for Scientific Achievement by the American Surgical Association and the Tanner-Vanderput-Boswick Burn Prize from the International Society for Burn Injuries. John Burke, M.D., former chief of staff of Shriners Hospitals for Children — Boston, was inducted into the Inventors Hall of Fame posthumously in 2015 for his work with the invention of artificial skin. Also, Shriners Hospitals for Children achieved amazing results using CO2 fractional laser therapy to help heal burn scars.

Shriners Hospitals for Children is proud of its work in the field of burn care and looks forward to continuing its legacy of leadership.




