The Law Governing Annual Elections-James Michael Guilinger, Potentate 2025

For the guidance of the Nobility, we publish the law regarding the proper way to conduct the election of Officers. From the By-Laws of Shriners International:

ARTICLE 25

Officers; Their Election or Appointment

§ 325.1 Officers.

(a) **List.** The officers of the temple are:

(1)	Potentate	Shayk
(2)	Chief Rabban	Emeer
(3)	Assistant Rabban	Sahib
(4)	High Priest and Prophet	Imam
(5)	Oriental Guide	Ayn
(6)	Treasurer	Chayzin
(7)	Recorder	Katib
(8)	First Ceremonial Master	Wakil
(9)	Second Ceremonial Master	Alam
(10)	Director	Malah
(11)	Marshal	Amal
(12)	Captain of the Guard	Rays
(13)	Outer Guard	Hafix

(b) **Limitation.** No person may hold more than one of the foregoing offices at the same time.

§ 325.2 Election and Qualification.

- (a) **Election Order.** The first 7 officers shall be elected annually, in the order in which they appear in § 325.1(a), by ballot and constitute the official divan. Candidates for the elective office in the shrine center must be members in good standing of that shrine center.
- (b) **Term Limit.** A Noble may not serve as Potentate of any shrine center for more than 2 years. However, a Noble may serve as Potentate for an additional 2 years if he has served in an office or offices on the official Divan other than Potentate, for at least 2 years subsequent to previous terms as Potentate and there are no other eligible candidates offering for election to the position as Potentate.
- (c) **Qualification.** A Noble may not serve as Potentate of any temple unless he shall have first served at least one term as either Chief Rabban or Assistant Rabban of a shrine center.
- (d) **Dispensation.** Upon a showing of good and sufficient cause, in writing and at least 60 days prior to the shrine center election, the Imperial potentate may waive the provisions of subsection (c) with respect to candidates for the office of Potentate at such shrine center election.
- § 325.3 Appointment. The other officers name in § 352.1 shall be anointed by the Potentate.
- § 325.4 When Elected. Each shrine center must elect its officers and representatives at its annual meeting in January unless its bylaws allow the election to occur at the shrine center's stated meeting in December.

§ 325.5 Ballot.

(a) **Separate Ballot**. Election of officers shall be by a majority vote of those present voting. When there is more than one candidate for election to an office, a separate written ballot is required. A blanket ballot is prohibited.

b) **Retention**. The ballots cast in any contested election for shrine center's office shall be retained in the custody of the Recorder for a period of 90 days following the election, after which they may be destroyed unless the Imperial Potentate otherwise orders.

(c) **Void Ballot**. Blank ballots or ballots containing any markings other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.

§ 325.6 Time of Election. Nominations must commence not later than 9:00pm and when that hour arrives all other business must cease, and none may be transacted until the election is concluded.

§ 325.7 Other Officers. The shrine center may elect such other officers as its bylaws provide.

§ 325.8 Nomination. Candidates for office and representative must be placed in nomination floor.

§ 325.9 Leadership Search Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint a committee consisting of note more than five (5) Nobles to study the qualifications of possible candidates for elective office in the shrine center. This committee may report their findings to the Board of Directors and/or to the shrine center's members in the form of a nomination at a shrine center election. This committee may also consult with the Chief Rabban on his appointments if so requested.

§ 325.10 Representatives.

- (a) **Single Ballot**. Where a shrine center elects more than one Representative, all candidates must be balloted for on one written ballot.
- (b) **Complete Ballot**. Each member voting must vote only for the total number of Representatives to be elected, otherwise his ballot cannot be counted as a vote.
- (c) Majority Vote. A majority vote of those present and voting is necessary to elect each Representative.
- (d) **Election**. Only those candidates who receive a majority vote shall be declared elected.
- (e) **Successive Ballots**. Successive written ballots must then be taken in the same manner on other candidates until all Representatives are elected.
- (f) **Highest Vote**. If more candidates receive a majority vote than the number of representatives to be elected, then those receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.
- (g) **Void Ballot**. Blank ballots or ballots containing any marking other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.

§ 325.11 Election Regulations.

- (a) **Electioneering**. A candidate for an elected office in a shrine center may print, publish, and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or contain the name of proposed candidates for office in the shrine center is prohibited.
- (b) **Expenditures Prohibited**. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for an elected office is prohibited.
- (c) **Violation**. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers' void and order a new election.
- (d) **Notice**. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

OFFICERS TO BE ELECTED FOR 2026 ARE; Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest & Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer, Recorder, Representative(s) to Shriners International for the year 2026, Representative(s) to the Central States Shrine Association, Representative(s) to the Finance & Investment Committee, and trustee(s) to the Building Association.

Fall is coming and with it ceremonial - now it is the time to get the novices lined up, if you have someone who is interested let the office know so we can help to get all the paperwork done. We will have a meeting to vote petitions the morning of ceremonial. This is going to be a very exciting day both for the new members and the rest of the nobility.

Dues notices will arrive shortly; we still have members who are delinquent for this year. If you want to help membership will be starting its last push for this year and begin on getting it ready for 2026. If you are interested in helping let the office know or contact the membership team directly. You can pay online through WebFez, you can mail it to the office, or you can stop by and pay your dues during regular business hours.

Building managers or trustees, all the keyless doors are now operational, a lot of small things are different now. To help facilitate the transition the office is ready to give everyone a walk through on how all the doors work now. If you have an alarm code you have access to the building, but do you know how to set the panic bars? The big stick has the tools to help you set each door; there do remain a few rooms that have key only access. If you want to be a building manager for the temple or just for your unit, come by the office for some quick updates. We will do individuals or groups just let us know so we can make it happen. Between now and the first of the year we currently have twenty-two events scheduled plus temple and unit meetings. This brings up events and building reservations, we have 15 events on the 2026 calendar and a couple of 2027 events. Now is the time to get 2026 event request turned in so they can be approved and printed in the calendar book.

Elections are coming before you know it. Units hold elections in November or at the last meeting of the year whichever is earlier. The results are due to the office no later than December 1st. In October, unit treasurers will receive instructions on completing the year in reports, these are due no later than 1st February. The forms are on the temple website. Temple elections will be held on December 9th, 2025 at the stated meeting. You must have your dues card to vote. The first notice of this election is included in this month "Rambling" and will be included every month in the Playground until December. Please review § 325.11 Election Regulations on electioneering every year a temple somewhere in Shrinedom gets in trouble over this so be careful how you go about putting your name out in front of the nobility. If

you are interested in an office come and see me with your questions. I would highlight that I will not be seeking reelection so one of you great nobles will have a chance to learn what goes on behind the curtain every day.

If anyone has a question or feedback, please let me know. I am generally in the office Monday through Thursday.


We are offering the Units to work the Bingo Concessions, food and drinks, and receive commission of sales as a Unit Fundraiser.
