



Our Fraternity is shrinking from when I proudly joined Abdallah Shriners in the Spring of 1994. Roughly 70% of our registered membership since 1994 have died or quit. We have welcomed new members over the years, but not even close to significantly slowing the downward trend.

There was once a phrase, often used by Potentates, Membership Committee members and many Nobles in times past which simply stated what we all wanted: 'Replace yourself plus one'. Simply put, find at least one good man to invite to be one of us as our replacement someday when we can't be active or die plus one more good man to grow the Fraternity. If most of us had not only listened to this lofty goal but also applied it in our Shrine, don't you believe that the shrinking membership would have been less concerning than it is now.

Some brothers have gone way beyond the basic '1 plus' with may new creations to their credit. Others have brought in several new members. The majority of our brothers have not found a single man worthy of becoming a Shriner. The reasons are varied. We have all heard that today's generations are not particularly interested in joining any group unless it involves their careers or their personal interests. They don't see much reason to be involved with social, community or philanthropic organizations. We also have heard that the very men that would benefit our Fraternity the most, the young and family men, are committed to making a living and supporting their families' activities, usually children's sports. This last statement is hard to argue with.

Somehow, we need to understand that for good men to be interested beyond their own interests and needs, our Fraternity has to be appealing with opportunities that these men can become involved with.

The other thing that has to happen is for more of us to quit wringing our hands about our relatively low membership numbers and do something about it. For starters, the list of unpaid dues members would be a good starting point. If someone is on that list and you know them, please call them, talk with them and encourage them to keep their good standing in a very good organization. Another thing we could do is be aware of men already Mason's who you think would make a good Shriner. Finally, look for men who should be Master Masons and help them navigate the process. One thing is for certain - hoping and thinking about membership is very good. Taking action is better.




