





# Message from Your Chief Rabban

I have great passion for what we do at Abdallah Shriners. I am proud of our fraternity and the many varieties of activities we have. Our event coordinators deserve and huge thank you for conceiving, planning, organizing, marketing and taking personal responsibility for our events.

When I view threats to our existence, I will fight with every tool I have to eliminate these threats. I view lack of attendance and participation as a very real and imminent threat to our existence.

You might have noticed I used the plural "Shrines". This is because we are not alone. # 2022 Imperial Session Report

Your temple was represented at the Imperial Secession by its elected representatives as well as be- ed representatives was request and then held. Our ing attended by several other members of the nobility. It was a busy secession with many decisions made that will impact our fraternity for many years ahead. This is a quick summary of those decisions:

### **IOWA CORPERATION CHANGES**

- PASSED. Changed number votes to approve bylaw change from 400 to 300 and retained the requirement to have at least 2/3 of those voting to approve.
- PASSED. Any noble appointed to an Imperial committee becomes a voting representative to the Iowa Corporation at Imperial.
- was a local state of emergency declared.
- FAILED. Stop paying \$20 a day per diem to representatives and a stop paying for spousal travel.
- PASSED. Members of Imperial Committee can be any nobles not just elected representatives.
- FAILED (Received more than 300 yes votes, but not 2/3 of those voting.) Per Capita Tax increase to \$50. Motion to reconsider passed but it still failed to receive enough votes.
- PASSED. Moving Emirat Shriners to Wiesbaden Germany.
- PASSED. Moving Media Shriners to Black River New York.
- PASSED. Change the maximum penalty for Frivolous or Bad Faith Complaints (Article 30s) to 1 year suspension.
- Withdrawn. Changing the Jurisdiction of Media Shriners.
- FAILED. Changing the Jurisdiction of Hikmat Shriners in Brazil.
- PASSED Changing the Jurisdiction of Amal Shriners in Brazil.
- PASSED Issuing a dispensation to form a temple in El Meten Lebanon. Temple to be named Lubnan Shriners.
- PASSED. Granting a charter to AI Atfal Shriners in Northern Mexico.
- PASSED. Removing the UD from AL Atfal Shriners. Added to the call.
- PASSED. Adding Lubnan Shriners Under Dispensation to the list in Article 104. Added to the call.

During the secession a formal roll call of all electrepresentatives were present. This is the first time in at least 15 years this has been done. There are almost 1100 elected representatives to the Imperial Secession, over 900 registered to attend and less than 700 answered the roll call.

He is a Master Mason, Black Hawk Lodge #65, Cedar Falls, Iowa, Member, Minneapolis Lodge #19, Minneapolis, Minnesota, Member, Scottish Rite, Valley of Minneapolis, Member, St. John's Chapter 9, Member, Minneapolis Council 2, Potentate, El Kahir Shriners, Hiawatha, Iowa, 2016, Mem-FAILED Participating in Imperial by Zoom if there ber, Zuhrah Shriners, Minnetonka, Minnesota, Member, Zuhrah Legion of Honor, Zuhrah Horseman and a Member, Cabiri International.

> The following COLORADO CORPERATION actions were voted on:

- PASSED Change number to approve bylaw change from 400 to 300.
- FAILED Who can approve the addition of hospitals or clinics.
- WITHDRAWN with the failure in the IOWA Corporation motion.
- PASSED. If the number of vacancies equal the number of candidates a paper ballot is not required.
- PASSED. Trustee age restriction was removed. It had been 72 years.
- PASSED The reauthorization of an Oversight Committee.

Bill Rasner and Chuck Pittman were elected to the board.

Status of locations looking to establish a temple was updated. Russia on hold over Ukraine War. South Africa shrine club is being established. Gabon shrine club is on hold due to pandemic





# Introducing the new My FezCard Viewer App

We're excited to announce the new digital membership card. Effective August 2022, Nobles who pay their 2023 dues will have immediate access to their newly designed digital Membership card. Nobles can access and present their digital membership card, which features the status of their dues two ways:

- My FezCard Viewer available for download on the Apple App Store or Google Play App Store
- Member Center located on the new SI.org Website •

For 2023, the two primary methods to determine if a member is current in their dues will include asking the Noble to present their new digital membership card on a mobile device or for the temple, club, or unit to scan the QR code on the Nobles existing hard card.

Scanning the QR code on the membership card, either the existing hard card or the new digital card, provides several benefits to the temple including in the areas of operations and as a member engagement tool:

### **Operations:**

- Decreases temple expenses by not having to pay for stickers and buckslip insert
- Simplifies operations, no need to replace stickers on an annual basis •
- Digital card/scanning QR guickly determines the status of dues payment •

### Member Engagement:

- Awarding credit for attendance at events and activities, which is especially handy for temples that award points and prizes for participation
- Expressing an interest in joining a club or unit •
- Registering for an event or volunteer opportunities

## As a result, Shriners International has discontinued the distribution of dues stickers to

individual Nobles. While the focus remains on scanning the QR code or presenting the digital card to determine the status of dues, to assist in the transition, a limited number of 2023 sticker sheets will be sent to each temple so they can provide a dues sticker to Nobles on a case-by-case or as-requested basis. When Nobles pay their 2023 membership dues they will receive a 5x8 acknowledgment postcard that will announce the new process along with instructions on how to obtain their new digital member ship card. To address three commonly asked questions:

How can a Noble access their digital card if we don't have internet access? If internet connectivity is a concern, once the Noble accesses their card via one of the two options above, they can take a screenshot of the digital card, which automatically saves to their photo gallery. Thereafter, they can present the card as needed without needing an internet connection.

How can a temple, club, or unit scan a QR code? From an operational standpoint, the barrier to entry to utilize the QR technology is extremely low and simple to use. For the last three years, several Temples have been scanning the QR code on the existing membership card to determine dues by purchasing a handheld scanner, available for as little as \$30, or a mobile device, like a phone or tablet. Both options connect and communicate with WebFez.

Will the digital card display associate temples? Currently only the Noble's home temple will display on the My FezCard Viewer; however, we expect to add a display featuring associate temples by late summer / early fall.




