- Gulf War (1990-1991) – 258
- War on Terror (2001-present) - 7, 075

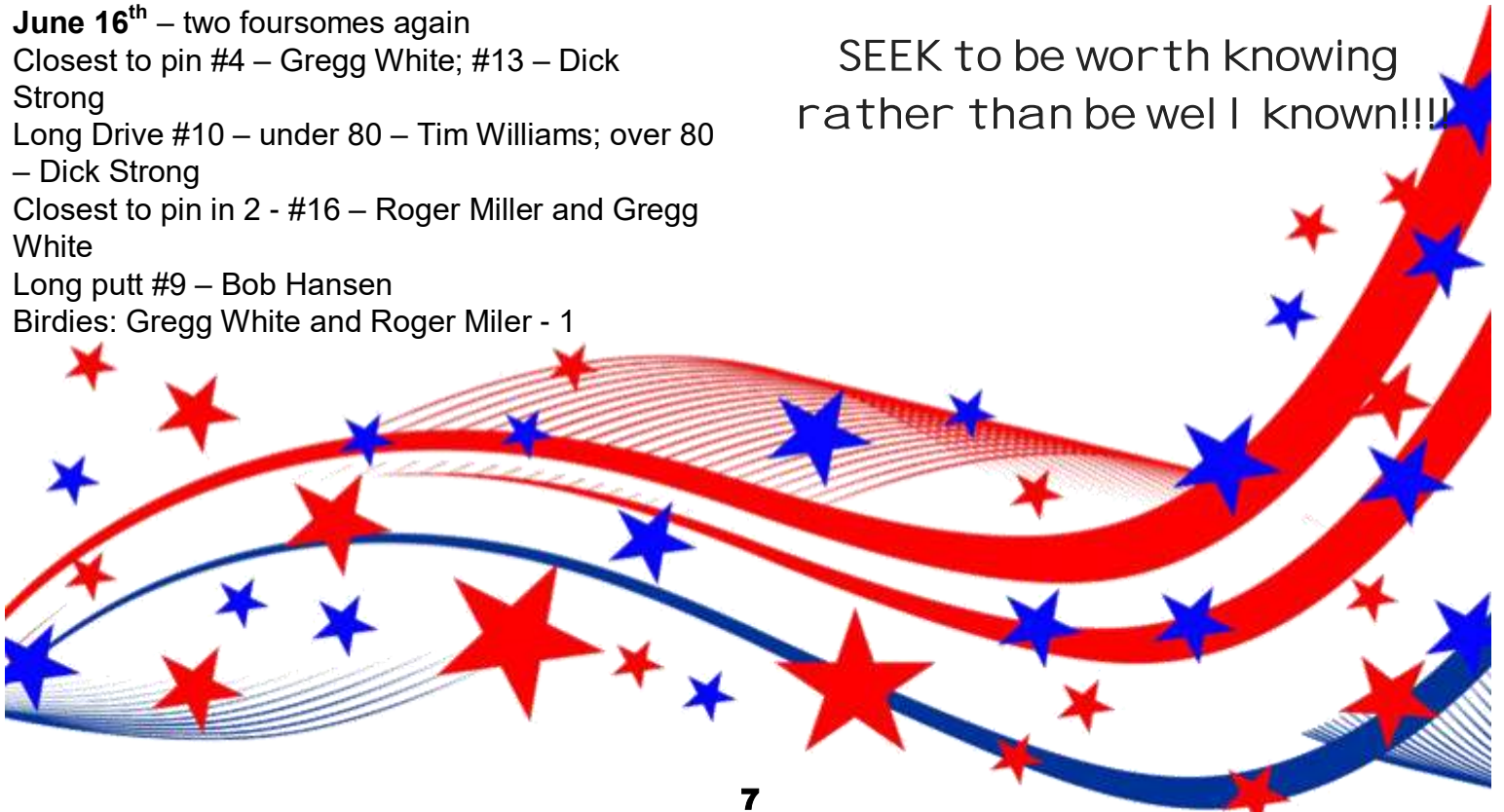

I charge each of you collectively, but more importantly individually, to reach into your heart and ask yourselves, "would I be a considered a good Shriner tomorrow base upon my actions today?" My hope and wish was this editorial had a more uplifting and positive message and conclusion, but it does not. Only the unknown future tells the truth of our destiny.

My promise as always is to be honest, forthcoming, and proactive during my tenure on Abdallah's divan.

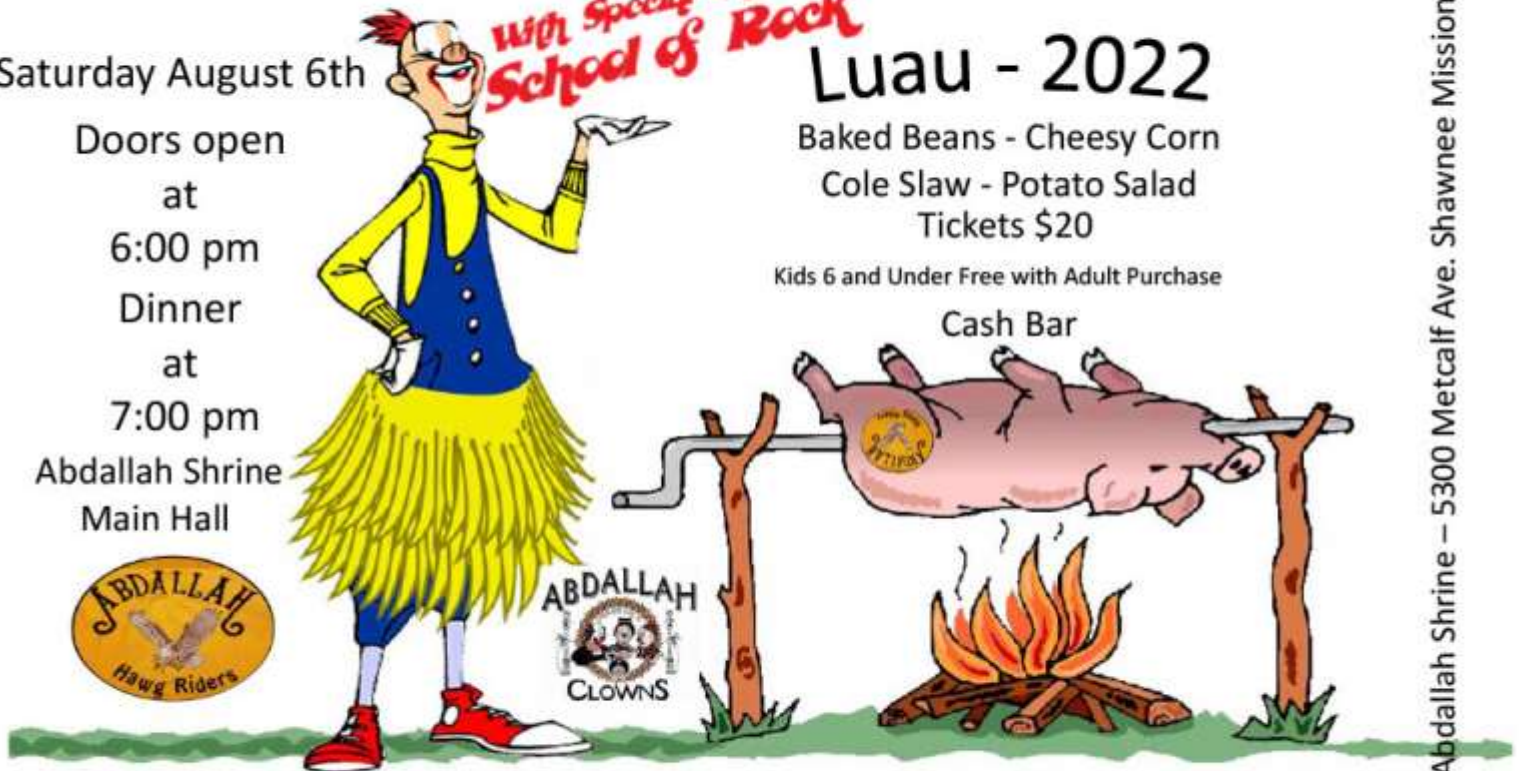

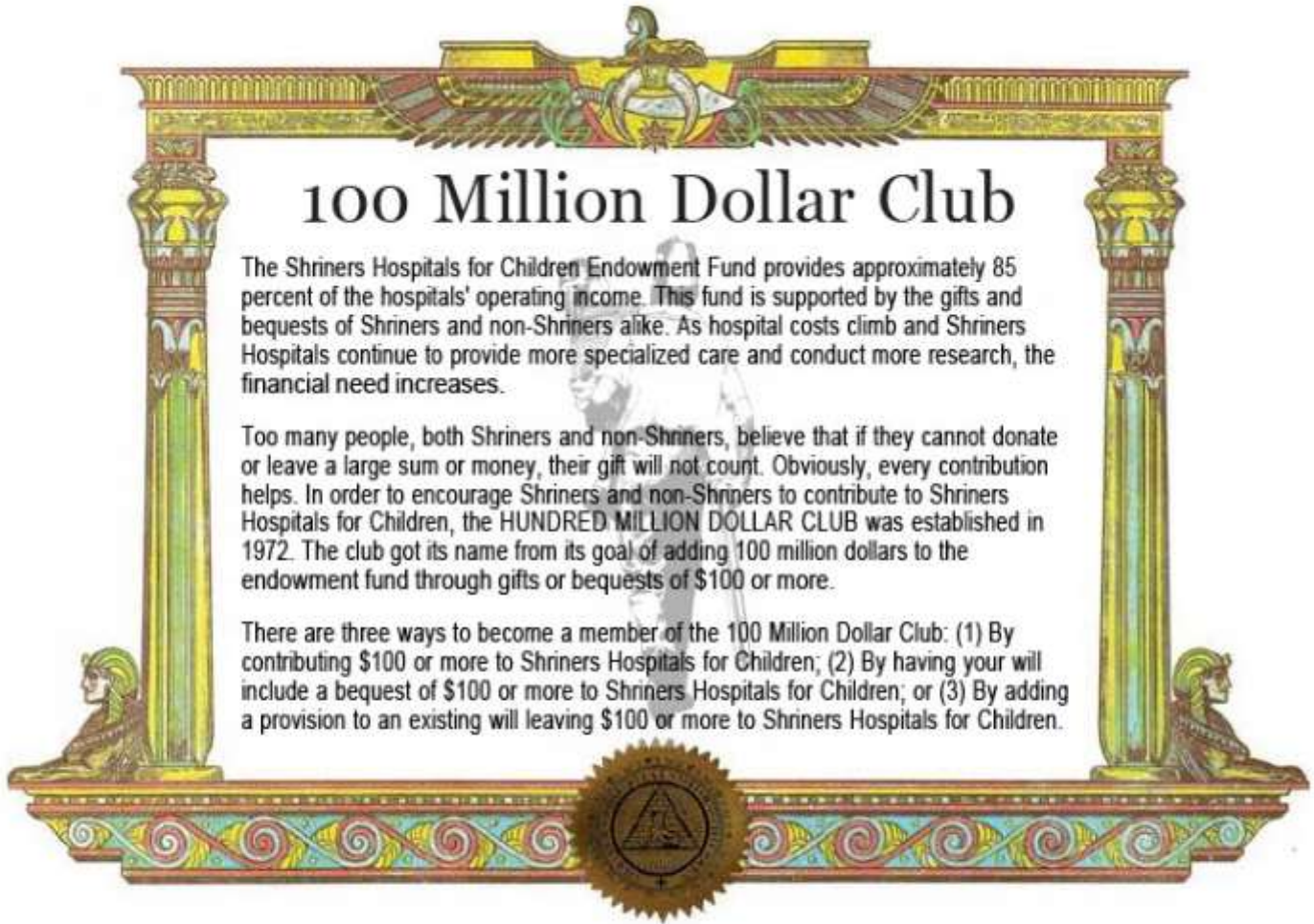
