



## Abdallah Shriners Facility Reopening Plan

The Divan of Abdallah Shriners met via Zoom on Friday, May 1, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. to discuss and plan the re-opening of the Abdallah Shriners facilities. After discussions and deliberations it was decided to error on caution, as we have added concerns for the majority of members who fall into the higher risk categories.

It was decided that a minimum, all Governmental Orders and Guidelines must be followed and the following structure and time line would be implemented:

**Shrine Building & Business office** – Reopen on Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup> with the following schedule and restrictions. **Hours:** Monday, Wednesday & Friday only, from 1pm to 4 pm. Only the south door will be unlocked. All visitors for any business with in the building must first check in at the office upon arrival and state their needs and locations within the building they will be going. No loitering in the lobby or any other room of the building.

**Meetings** – NO unit or club meetings before June 1<sup>st</sup>. Phase 3 of the Kansas reopening plan must be in effect. This allows for up to 90 participants. June stated meeting possible at the Abdallah Shrine Temple.

**Bingo** – Not before July 6th and Phase 4 must be in effect. Implementation details need to be worked out with the Bingo Committee.

Hall Rental & Main Hall activities open to the public – None until July 1<sup>st</sup> and Phase 4 is enacted.

**Oasis (Bar)** – Closed until July 3<sup>rd</sup> and Phase 4 is enacted.

To some, this may seem to be pushed out too far, but the management of Abdallah must have time to secure all necessary and ample stock of cleaning and disinfectant materials. These items are in short supply currently. We need to work with our cleaning service to provide the necessary cleaning and disinfectant solutions. Also, we will need to reestablish services that had been put on hold to save money during the closure.

On the next page is a summary chart of the Kansas plan but keep in mind that the dates shown are fluid and the phases do not go into effect until an order by the governor is released. Again, the Divan has set the Abdallah schedule on the side of caution to protect our members and our facility as much as possible. We will continue to make Zoom available for any Unit or Club to hold meetings or just have group communications. All you need to do is coordinate with your Divan rep and he can set it up for you.

Please take cautions in your public outings and stay safe!

The chart below outlines a simplified view of the Sate of Kansas reopening phase plan. The dates shown are not before dates and are not effective until a move to the next phase order is released by the governor's office. Johnson County has extended it's stay at home order through May 10th. It will then follow the the States order.

Please remember that COVID-19 has not gone away. Continue to practice social distancing. Even when Abdallah starts resuming meetings, NO handshaking, NO hugging, and face masks are encouraged.


# Table Cloths Reminder

# How to make a Face Mask

### What you will need

- Cotton fabric, a pretty print is best.
- Rope Elastic, beading cord elastic will work (you may also us 1/8" flat elastic)
- Cut the elastic 7" long and tie a knot at each end (DO NOT knot the ends of the flat)

You can make two sizes: Adult or Child

- Put right sides of cotton fabric together

   Cut 9x6 (Adult) or 7.5 x 5 (Child)
- Starting at the center of the bottom edge, sew to the first corner, stop. Sew the elastic with the edge out into the corner. A few stitches forward and back will hold this.
- Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of the same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.
- 4. Now sew across that top of the mask to the next corner. Again put an elastic with the edge out.
- 5. Sew to the next corner and sew in the other end of the same elastic.
- 6. Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5" to 2" open. Stop, cut the thread. Turn inside out.
- 7. Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are the same direction
- 8. Sew around the edge of the mask twice.

It is so easy to make this.

Be sure any fabric design is placed horizontally.






