



CSSA report will be presented at the May meeting.


Glow sticks will be purchased for Provost Members' visibility at the Bull Bash and Demolition Derby.

The Sergeant-at-Arms reports 2 Provost shirts have become available. Contact Don if you need a shirt. Sizes to be determined.






