The POTENTATE'S MESSAGE

Greetings from the Potentate,

Fall is coming and it has been a great summer. September will see the 2024 dues notices going out and unfortunately, we still have a few folks who need to take care of 2023 dues. If there are issues, please let your leadership know how we can help. If you have membership questions, please find someone from the membership team we can help. This includes any noble that might need some help with his dues.

This year's CSSA was an exciting time. It is one of the events that gives all of us an opportunity to meet with other Shriners and share the experiences that makes this one of the greatest parts of the Masonic fraternity. All those who went to Omaha this year take a moment and share your experiences with your friends and members of your unit.

The Shrine needs your help with our rental events. We need building managers and other assistances with other parts of the rental process, so if you have the time and opportunity, please step up for the chance to be part of the team on this. It looks like we will have a very busy fall with several events that can use your help. We have events not only on weekends, but also during the weekday.


Again, it is time to say thanks to all those who are helping with things around the Shrine. Whether it is Unit events, taking care of the grounds and the building, working Bingo, being a building manager or the Provost during a rental, or helping with the office work; your efforts are helping make things work for us. Please come out and be part of the fun. We really look forward to seeing each and every one of you at our next event.

From the Treasurer's Desk:

The 2024 dues notices will be sent via email, to those with an email address on file, around September 8th & 9th, so keep an eye on your inbox. Using email saves us several hundred dollars per year in postage. In case you haven't heard, there was a bylaw change at the 2023 Imperial Session to raise the PerCapita Tax from \$30 per year to \$50 per year, starting with the 2024 dues year. Therefore, if you are not a PerCapita Life member you will see a \$20 increase in your dues. There is still time to purchase a Per Capita Tax Life Membership for 30 times the old rate of \$30 per year or \$900 total. This would exclude you from paying the PerCapita Tax in the future.

Rember, you can pay your dues directly through your WebFez acount, (see next page if you're not setup yet) and even set up a future instalment plan. When you have paid your dues, you will NOT be mailed a sticker for your hard dues card. You must request it from the Abdallah Shriners office. For those who opted to use the MyFezCard viewer app, it will update automatically when the payments process through the system. Allow a week after making payment.

For those of you who are Total Life Members and using the MyFezCard Viewer app, your dues card should have already updated. For those Total Life Members still wanting to use the plastic dues cards, stickers will be available from the office after October 1st. Remember, they will NOT be mailed automatically. The Abdallah Office can you mail you one, but you must request it otherwise we do not know to send it to you.



Nobles, you can pay your dues and even set-up a payment plan for monthly, quarterly or bi-annual payments through WebFez. It's easy to set-up, just follow the directions below. Remember, dues are paid in advance so you could be making installments now for 2024.

Use WebFez to verify your personal information, payments and Shrine activity

How to Register for WebFez:

- Go to your browser's address bar and type in webfez.shrinenet.org
- Click the register button on the Login page: Register
- From the Registration page, choose your Temple from the drop-down list and then type in your Member Number and your First and Last names.
- Click on the Register button. You will be directed to the Create a New Account page. On this page enter an E-mail address that you will use to log in with, confirm the E-mail address, and then enter and confirm your Password.



The new My FezCard Viewer App

We're excited to announce the new digital membership card. Effective August 2022, Nobles who pay their 2023 dues will have immediate access to their newly designed digital Membership card. Nobles can access and present their digital membership card, which features the status of their dues two ways:



- My FezCard Viewer available for download on the Apple App Store or Google Play App Store
- Member Center located on the new SI.org Website

For 2023, the two primary methods to determine if a member is current in their dues will include asking the Noble to present their new digital membership card on a mobile device or for the temple, club, or unit to scan the QR code on the Nobles existing hard card.

Scanning the QR code on the membership card, either the existing hard card or the new digital card, provides several benefits to the temple including in the areas of operations and as a member engagement tool:

Operations:

- Decreases temple expenses by not having to pay for stickers and buckslip insert
- Simplifies operations, no need to replace stickers on an annual basis
- Digital card/scanning QR quickly determines the status of dues payment

Member Engagement:

- Awarding credit for attendance at events and activities, which is especially handy for temples that award points and prizes for participation
- Expressing an interest in joining a club or unit
- Registering for an event or volunteer opportunities

As a result, Shriners International has discontinued the distribution of dues stickers to individual Nobles. While the focus remains on scanning the QR code or presenting the digital card to determine the status of dues, to assist in the transition, a limited number of 2023 sticker sheets will be sent to each temple so they can provide a dues sticker to Nobles on a case-by-case or as-requested basis. When Nobles pay their 2023 membership dues they will receive a 5x8 acknowledgment postcard that will announce the new process along with instructions on how to obtain their new digital member ship card. To address three commonly asked questions:

How can a Noble access their digital card if we don't have internet access? If internet connectivity is a concern, once the Noble accesses their card via one of the two options above, they can take a screenshot of the digital card, which automatically saves to their photo gallery. Thereafter, they can present the card as needed without needing an internet connection.

How can a temple, club, or unit scan a QR code? From an operational standpoint, the barrier to entry to utilize the QR technology is extremely low and simple to use. For the last three years, several Temples have been scanning the QR code on the existing membership card to determine dues by purchasing a handheld scanner, available for as little as \$30, or a mobile device, like a phone or tablet. Both options connect and communicate with WebFez.

Will the digital card display associate temples? Currently only the Noble's home temple will display on the My FezCard Viewer, however, we expect to add a display featuring associate temples by late summer / early fall.

The result of this effort is designed to directly reduce temple expenses, simplify operations, and increase member engagement.





Everyone should be familiar with the following fundraising guidelines and be aware that the disclosure and statement of purpose can and should be applied to any information that published and available to the public whether it is a "fundraiser" or not.

Shriners International Fundraising Policies & Proceedures

Introduction

Because Shriners have been the driving force behind Shriners Hospitals for Children®, it has become natural to associate the Fez with this charity. However, Shriners International and Shriners Hospitals for Children are separate and distinct legal corporations.

Shriners Hospitals for Children is a 501(c)(3) incorporated in the state of Colorado, and it operates 22 locations. Its purpose is to provide medical care to children without regard to race, creed, sect or nationality. The treatment is provided regardless of the families' ability to pay. This is the Charitable corporation.

Shriners International is incorporated in the state of lowa, and it presently has nearly 200 unincorporated fraternal associations in several countries. We know them as Shrine Temples. This is the Fraternal corporation.

Particular attention must be given to all fundraising activities to make certain that such activities comply with the law of the land and that a contributor is not led to believe that his money will be used for the Hospitals when all or a portion therefore may be used otherwise.

Types of Fundraisers

There are two types of Shrine fundraisers – Charitable and Fraternal.

Charitable Fundraisers – Where 100 percent of the net proceeds benefit Shriners Hospitals for Children. (See pages 3-6.)

Fraternal Fundraisers – Where the net proceeds benefit the Temple, which in turn may distribute them as it sees fit. For example, profits may be disbursed to the Temple general fund, a building fund, to clubs and/or units, to Shriners Hospitals for Children, to local community or Masonic related projects (DeMolay, Masonic Home, etc.) or any combination thereof.

Procedures That Apply to All Shrine Fundraising Activities

• All fundraising must comply with the law of the land; that is, the law of the jurisdiction where the activity takes place. This includes national, state or province, and local laws.

- The use of the name Shriners Hospitals for Children is governed by §503.11 of the bylaws of Shriners Hospitals for Children.
- All fundraising is governed by General Order No. 1 as may be issued on that subject by the Imperial Potentate.
- Insurance: Your attention should be directed to that portion of the existing General Order No.1 pertaining to insurance. Strict compliance is required.
- All contracts must be reviewed and approved by the Temple Potentate after receiving the advice of the Temple attorney.
- All fundraising promotional materials (including Temple publications) must include a statement indicating the major entity benefited by the funds [Statement of Purpose]

Statements of Purpose and Disclosure

All fundraising promotional materials must contain a STATEMENT OF PURPOSE. Below are examples for each

type of fundraising activity.

For Charitable Fundraisers:

"Proceeds are for the benefit of Shriners Hospitals for Children."

For Fraternal Fundraisers: "Proceeds are for the benefit of (______ Shriners) (______ shrine unit/club) activities."



DISCLOSURE: "Payments are not deductible as charitable contributions."
