Notice is hereby given that a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Burnet County Emergency Services District No. 7 will be held on **Monday, January 22, 2024, at 5:30 p.m.**, at the Burnet Community Center at 401 E. Jackson Street, Burnet, Texas 78611, for the following purposes:

1. Call meeting to order;
2. Public Comment on Agenda Items: Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes per person per agenda item. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of thirty minutes per item on the agenda. Members of the public will speak on an agenda item after comments on the item are called for by the presiding officer, but before Board discussion and consideration of the item.

5. Receive monthly report from the Treasurer and consider:

 - (d) current year budget amendments as necessary;

7. Receive monthly report from Lampasas Volunteer Fire Department regarding financial matters, training, management activities, membership, and emergency operations and out of station times (including breakdown by apparatus) and call volume for fire/rescue calls and for EMS calls;
8. Receive monthly report from the City of Burnet Fire Department regarding financial matters, training, management activities and personnel, membership, and emergency operations and out of station times (including breakdown by apparatus) and call volume for fire/rescue calls and for EMS calls;

- 14. Discuss planned installation of and access to water tank at Reliable Tire Disposal, 3345 East State Highway 29 in Burnet, and consider partially funding cost of installation for District benefit;
- 15. Receive status report on strategic planning issues, discuss short-term and long-term goals for the District, and consider taking any necessary action;
- 16. Public Comment: Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three (3) minutes regarding general topics that are not on the current agenda. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of thirty minutes on items not on the current agenda. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda; and
