Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Burnet County Emergency Services District No. 7 will be held on **Tuesday, August 9, 2022, at 5:30 p.m.**, at the Burnet Community Center at 401 E. Jackson Street, Burnet, Texas 78611, for the following purposes:

1. Call meeting to order;
2. Public Comment on Agenda Items: Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes per person per agenda item. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of thirty minutes per item on the agenda. Members of the public will speak on an agenda item after comments on the item are called for by the presiding officer, but before Board discussion and consideration of the item.

3. Discuss and consider apparatus request from service providers;
4. Discuss establishing station in Zone C for Burnet Volunteer Fire Department;
5. Discuss and consider action regarding 2022-2023 budget;
6. Discuss and consider taking action regarding 2022 tax rate, including:
 - (a) Establishing proposed tax rate;
 - (b) Taking record vote and scheduling public hearing;
 - (c) Authorizing publication of “Notice of Public Hearing/Meeting on Tax Increase/Rate” in *Lampasas Dispatch* and *The Highlander*; and
 - (d) Acknowledging and approving posting of “Notice About 2022 Tax Rates” and “Notice of Public Hearing/Meeting on Tax Increase/Rate.”
7. Public Comment: Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three (3) minutes regarding general topics that are not on the current agenda. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of thirty minutes on items not on the current agenda. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda; and
8. Discuss agenda, time, and date for next meeting.
