MINUTES

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Burnet County Emergency Services District No. 7 was held on **Monday, October 27, 2025, at 5:30 p.m.**, at the Burnet Community Center at 401 E. Jackson Street, Burnet, Texas 78611, for the following purposes:

Brenda Goble requested a sign be placed near the road to indicate that the property is for a future Burnet Volunteer Fire Department Station. Chief Daniels indicated he would handle that. Brenda Goble also advised that the Homeowners' Association in that area requires construction be completed within a certain time period, once it begins, and that time period may be just one year. No action taken.

Receive status report on strategic planning issues, discuss short-term and long-term goals for the District, and consider taking any necessary action: Brenda Goble stated that the Hill Country 100 Club will be making monetary donations, up to \$13,000, to local volunteer fire departments through a grant process.
