

RESOLUTION NO. 11-26
RESOLUTION DECLARING WATER CONSERVATION EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Sub-normal moisture for the past several months has adversely affected the city's water supply; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems that the present water supply is in imminent danger of being inadequate to satisfy all essential and non-essential uses;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Rock Rapids Municipal Utilities, that a WATER CONSERVATION EMERGENCY is hereby declared.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following uses of potable processed water from the Municipal Water System during the Water Conservation Emergency are hereby prohibited:

- (1) Watering or irrigation of lawns and all other outside vegetation, except that watering is permitted between the hours of 8:00 PM and 8:00 AM the following day.

Nothing in paragraph 1 above shall prohibit the use of water that has been reclaimed or recycled after an essential primary use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any person found to be using city water in violation of this resolution shall be charged twice the rate that would otherwise apply. This rate shall apply to all metered service through the service connection used in perpetrating the violation during any month that a Water Conservation Emergency is declared by the Board of Trustees to exist and during which the violation has occurred or continued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any person found to be using city water in violation of this resolution for the second or any subsequent time during any declared conservation emergency will have their water service disconnected without further notice, in addition to the penalty prescribed in the paragraph above. Reconnection will occur during normal business hours after payment of the reconnection fee established in Section 49 of the "Rules and Regulations" of the water utility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Water Conservation Emergency shall become effective June 3, 2026 and remain in effect until such time the Board adopts a resolution declaring the emergency to be terminated.

RESOLUTION NO. 14-26
RESOLUTION DECLARING WATER CONSERVATION EMERGENCY AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, Sub-normal moisture for the past several months has adversely affected the city's water supply; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems that the present water supply is currently adequate to allow for watering of newly seeded or sodded lawns;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Rock Rapids Municipal Utilities, that a WATER CONSERVATION EMERGENCY is hereby amended by adding the following language:

(2) Newly installed sod and seeded areas may still be watered under irrigation guidelines established by Iowa State University, as amended

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other portions of the Water Conservation Emergency effective June 3, 2026, remain in effect, except any portion that conflicts with the amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Water Conservation Emergency Amendment shall become effective July 1, 2026, and remain in effect until such time the Board adopts a resolution declaring the emergency to be terminated.
