HOW TO TELL IF YOU HAVE A GAS LEAK

Signs of natural gas leaks can be found through the 3 main senses:



Do you smell rotten eggs?

Natural gas is odorless in its natural state. For your safety, a distinctive odor similar to rotten eggs or sulfur is added.

The stronger the odor, the more likely you have a leak.



Do you hear whistling or hissing?

These noises could be gas escaping from your pipes.

Especially near a gas line or appliance.

Persistent bubbling in standing water or mud.



Dirt or dust being blown into the air.

Soil that appears blackish-green.
Discolored or dead vegetation in an otherwise green area.

If a leak has been ignited, the fire might appear to hover above the ground.
