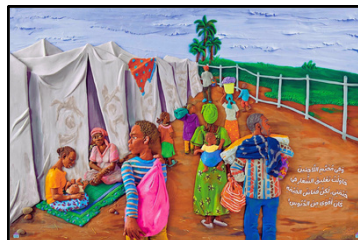


Small Homes

place in the world.

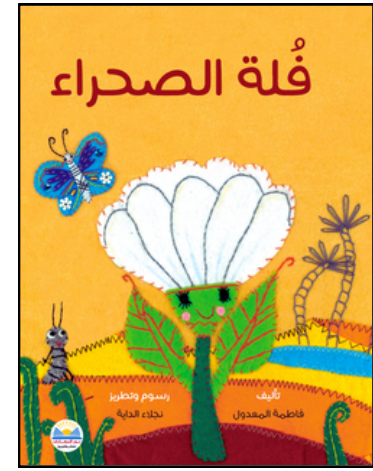


Jasmin in The Desert
