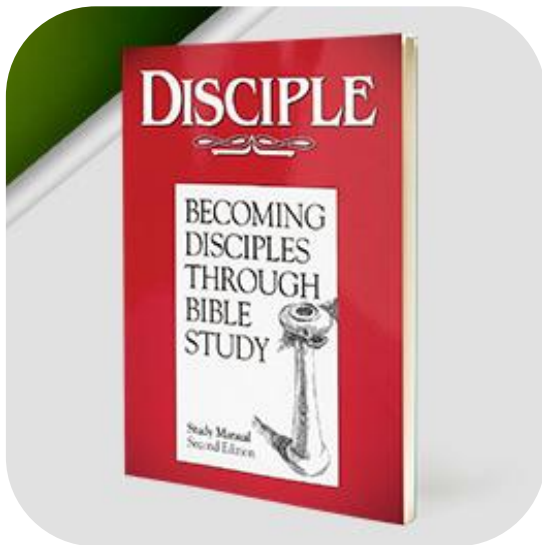

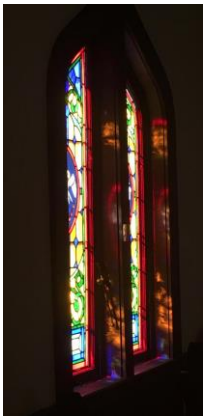

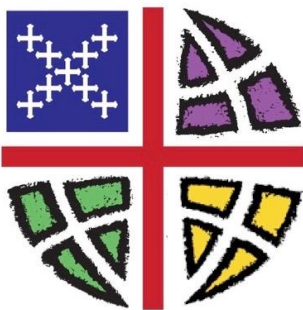
"Sally was one of the last of her kind; a strong southern woman, who cared about others – maybe to a fault".
