PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (Commission) hereby files a Complaint against Promoting Responsible Government (Respondent Committee) and Renee Nicastro (Respondent Nicastro) and offers Respondents the opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq., to determine whether Respondents failed to comply with the New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq. (Campaign Act) and N.J.A.C. 19:25-1 et seq. (Commission Regulations), and whether penalties should be imposed.

The Commission by way of Complaint alleges:

COUNT ONE

PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. Respondent Committee is a continuing political committee in New Jersey.
- Respondent Committee designated Respondent Nicastro as organizational treasurer on the Form D-4 filed August 29, 2013 and reported the establishment of a depository account named "Promoting Responsible Government" (depository).
- 3. Respondent Committee and Respondent Nicastro will be referred to collectively as Respondents.
- 4. Upon information and belief, between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022, Respondents deposited 26 contributions into the depository totaling \$28,518.87 and made 12 expenditures from the depository totaling \$17,738.74.
- 5. As of the date of this Complaint, Respondents have not filed quarterly reports for calendar year 2022 and have not reported any contributions received or expenditures made in 2022.

PROPOSED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- Respondent Committee was at all times relevant to this Complaint a continuing political committee as defined at N.J.S.A. 19:44A-3n, and therefore was subject to the requirements of the Campaign Act and Commission Regulations.
- 7. Respondent Nicastro was at all times relevant to this Complaint the organizational treasurer for Respondent Committee, and therefore was subject to the requirements of the Campaign Act and Commission Regulations.
- 8. Respondents were required, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-9.1 to report all contributions received and expenditures made, as follows:
 - a. Transactions between January 1, 2022 and March 31, 2022 were required to be reported on the 2022 first quarterly report on April 18, 2022;
 - Transactions between April 1, 2022 and June 30, 2022 were required to be reported on the 2022 second quarterly report on July 15, 2022;
 - c. Transactions between July 1, 2022 and September 30, 2022 were required to be reported on the 2022 third quarter report on October 17, 2022; and

- d. Transaction between October 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022 were required to be reported on the 2022 fourth quarterly report on January 17, 2023.
- 9. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-10.2, for each contribution exceeding \$300.00 received during a reporting period, Respondents were required to include the (1) date of receipt; (2) contribution amount; (3) contributor's name; and (4) contributor's address. Where the contributor was an individual, N.J.A.C. 19:25-10.2A required Respondents to include (5) contributor's occupation and (6) the name and address of his or her employer.
- 10. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-10.3, Respondents were required to report the sum of contributions of \$300 or less for each reporting period.
- 11. For each expenditure made during a reporting period, Respondents were required, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8 and 19:25-12.2, to report the date the expenditure was made, the full name and address of the payee, the purpose and amount, and the number of the check.
- 12. Respondents violated N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8, N.J.A.C. 19:25-9.1, 19:25-10.2, 19:25-10.2A, and 19:25-10.3 by failing to report 26 contributions totaling \$28,518.87 on 2022 quarterly reports.
- 13. Respondents violated N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8, N.J.A.C. 19:25-9.1, and N.J.A.C. 19:25-12.2 by failing to report 12 expenditures totaling \$17,738.74 on 2022 quarterly reports.
- 14. Respondents are each subject to imposition by the Commission of the penalties prescribed by N.J.S.A. 19:44A-22 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-17.1 et seq., which penalties may not be more than \$9,800.00 for each reporting transaction not reported in the manner or time prescribed by the Campaign Act or Commission Regulations.

COUNT TWO

PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 15. The Proposed Findings of Fact contained in Count One are repeated and incorporated herein.
- 16. Upon information and belief, Respondents made or incurred three expenditures to a single vendor between April 1, 2022 and June 7, 2022 to defeat candidates in the 2022 primary election, totaling \$7,805.
- 17. Respondents did not file a notice of each expenditure within 48 hours or at any time prior to the 2022 primary election.

PROPOSED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 18. The Proposed Conclusions of Law contained in Count One are repeated and incorporated herein.
- 19. Respondents were required, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-9.4, to report within 48 hours expenditures in excess of \$1,900.00, or aggregate expenditures in excess of \$1,900.00, made, incurred or authorized between April 1, 2022 and June 7, 2022 to support or defeat a candidate in the 2022 primary election, except that expenditures prior to May 25, 2022 could have been reported together on a notice no later than May 27, 2022 (48-hour expenditures).
- 20. Respondents violated N.J.S.A. 19:44A-8 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-9.4 by failing to file a notice of the 48-hour expenditures described in paragraph 16.
- 21. Respondents are each subject to imposition by the Commission of the penalties prescribed by N.J.S.A. 19:44A-22 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-17.1 et seq., which penalties may not be more than \$9,800.00 for each reporting transaction not reported in the manner or time prescribed by the Campaign Act or Commission Regulations.

OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING:

Respondents have the opportunity for a hearing pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:25-17.1. To effectuate that opportunity, a hearing must be requested in writing. Respondents may appear personally or by attorney. However, if Respondents fail to file a written answer with the Commission within 20 days of service of this Complaint, the Commission will be empowered to enter a Final Decision, including imposition of a monetary penalty, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:25-17.1A.

I have reviewed the amended filings for the above referenced case. The reports have been amended correctly and completely. As such, the recommended penalty for the above captioned matter is broken down below.

- 1) Late reporting of 26 contributions totaling \$28,518.87: \$2,851.88
- 2) Late reporting of 12 expenditures totaling \$17,738.74: \$1,773.87
- 3) Failing to file 48-hour notice for a \$1,400 contribution: \$700
- 4) Failing to file 48-hour notice for a \$2,045 contribution: \$1,022.50
- 5) Failing to file 48-hour notice for a \$4,360 contribution: \$2,180

The recommended penalty above totals \$8,528.25 against Respondents jointly. Should the penalty be paid in full or partial payment received prior to Final Decision action, the recommended penalty would further be reduced to \$6,822.60.

A payment plan is available for the recommended penalty. A payment plan would require an initial payment of 20% of the penalty amount and four equal payments due quarterly. Staff penalty recommendations must be approved by the Commission.
