

>> SOME JUNE HISTORY <<

Monday, June 1st; "*Statehood Day*"

On June 1, 1796, Tennessee became the 16th state of the Union. It celebrates the anniversary of the

On **June 5, 1820; "James K. Polk"** (U.S. President 1845-1849) received his 1st degree in Columbia Lodge #31, Columbia, TN.



General Dwight D.
Eisenhower called the operation a crusade in which "we will accept nothing less than full victory". More than 5,000 ships and 13,000 aircraft supported the D-Day invasion. It is considered one

of history's most significant military attacks.

On June 11, 1745; "David Brearley"

was born. He was a signer of the American Constitution. In 1787, at the Constitution Convention, Brearley chaired the committee on which played a significant role in



determining the final draft of the U S Constitution. Brearley was the first Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of New Jersey. Elected in 1786, it is believed that he was initiated into Military Lodge No. 19 in Pennsylvania, although there is no record of him ever affiliating with a lodge in New Jersey.

On June 13th, 1838; "Walter Millard Fleming" was born in Portland, Maine. Fleming was an American surgeon and one of the founders of the Ancient Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine (A.A.O.N.M.S.).



Fleming joined Rochester Lodge No. 660 in Rochester, New York.

He was also a 33° Scottish Rite Mason.

On **June 14, 1777,** the "Continental Congress" replaced the British symbols of the Grand Union flag with a new design featuring 13 white stars in a circle on a field of blue and 13 red and white stripes – one for each state, as the official flag of the United States.

In June 1886 Bernard Cigrand made his first public proposal for the annual observance of the birth of the flag when he wrote an article titled "The Fourteenth of June". President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation calling for a nationwide observance of the event on June 14, 1916.

Flag Day became official August 1949, when President Harry Truman signed the legislation and proclaimed June 14 as Flag Day. In 1966, Congress also requested that the President issue annually a proclamation designating the week in which June 14 occurs as National Flag Week.

On June 14, 1775; The U.S. Army



was founded, when the Continental Congress authorized enlistment of riflemen to serve the United Colonies for one year.

Wednesday, June 24; "St. John's Night"

The Feast of Saint John the Baptist
In the Masonic tradition, John the
Baptist is recognized as the patron
saint of stonemasons in the Middle
Ages throughout Europe.



A guild of stonemasons and carpenters in Germany was called the *Fraternity of Saint John the Baptist*. The founding of the premier Grand Lodge of England in 1717, it was formed on June 24th.
