On **March 2nd, 1793**,
"Samuel 'Sam' Houston"
was born around Lexington,
Virginia.

He moved with his family to
Tennessee at the age of 14.

In 1813, Houston would become part of the
Tennessee militia. After the war, in 1818 he would
be named the local prosecutor in Nashville.

In 1822, Houston won the U S House of
Representatives seat for TN and in 1827, would be
elected as Governor of TN.

On **March 3, 1753**, **"George Washington"**
received His Fellow Craft Degree in
Fredericksburg Lodge in Virginia.

On **March 6, 1775**, several black men, including
one named **Prince Hall**, were initiated into
Freemasonry in Boston. This marked the beginning
of what became a huge movement or organization
in the United States known as **Prince Hall
Masonry**, composed mainly of African Americans.



On this date in **March 9, 1822**,
a National Masonic Congress was held in
Washington DC, in the U.S. Capitol building.

On **March 15th, 1767**, **"Andrew Jackson"**
(7th President of the U.S.) was born in the area of
the North Carolina and South Carolina border prior
to the land being surveyed.

By the age of 14, Jackson was an orphan and had
lost his entire family.

By 1787, Jackson had taught school, worked for a
saddle maker and studied law and pass the bar. In
1796 Jackson would be the first Representative to
the U S House of Representatives for the new state
of Tennessee. In 1796 he was elected to the U S
Senate. In 1798 he was appointed as a Judge on the
Tennessee Supreme Court.

In 1828, Jackson was nominated by the Tennessee
Legislature for President and would win the
election and serve as president until 1837.
After leaving office, Jackson would retire to his
plantation, The Hermitage and passed away there
on June 8th, 1845.

Jackson was initiated into Harmony Lodge No. 1
in Tennessee and was instrumental in founding
other lodges in the state. He was the only President
to have been a Grand Master of a state until
Harry S. Truman in 1945.
