



Message from the Executive Director

Dear ECUA Employees:

In light of the growing availability of COVID-19 vaccines in our area and new guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC), I have decided to lift ECUA's mask mandate for employees who are fully vaccinated effective immediately. According to the CDC, a person is deemed fully vaccinated two weeks after receiving the second dose of a two-dose vaccine or two weeks after receiving a one-dose vaccine.

Although masks are no longer required for those who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19, I encourage non-vaccinated employees to remain vigilant and request they continue following the CDC's guidance on how to best protect themselves and others at work and at home, by:

- Getting a COVID-19 vaccine if eligible.
- Wearing a mask that covers your nose and mouth when out in public or around people who do not live inside your household.
- Practicing social distancing by avoiding large gatherings and maintaining distance of at least six feet from others when possible.
- Washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or using hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Practicing routine cleaning and disinfection of frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- Staying home if you are sick.

We will continue to monitor the circumstances surrounding COVID-19 and provide updates as new information becomes available.
