



## Message from the Executive Director

Dear ECUA Employees:

Based on the recent decline of COVID-19 cases in our area, I have decided to once again lift ECUA's mask mandate for employees effective immediately. As previously stated, although masks are no longer required in the workplace, I encourage employees to remain vigilant and follow the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) guidance on how to best protect themselves and others at work and at home, by:

- Getting a COVID-19 vaccine if eligible.
- Staying home if you are sick.
- Wearing a mask that covers your nose and mouth when out in public or around people who do not live inside your household.
- Practicing social distancing by avoiding large gatherings and maintaining distance of at least six feet from others when possible.
- Washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or using hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Practicing routine cleaning and disinfection of frequently touched objects and surfaces.

We will continue to monitor the circumstances surrounding COVID-19 and provide updates as new information becomes available.
