## Brothers,

As always, the St. Patrick's Day season was a busy one for Division. On Saturday, March  $8^{th}$ , many of our members competed in the annual Tipp Hill Shamrock Run. Proceeds from that great event go to the Syracuse St. Patrick Hunger Project. On March  $15^{th}$ , we again led the procession at the Cathedral for the St. Patrick's Mass. We had a nice turn-out for the parade and we looked sharp!

Congratulations to AOH Syracuse Division member Tom Ryan, who was the winner of the "Early Bird" dues payment drawing and, as such, will have his 2015 dues paid for by the Division!

As you know, we are planning a bus trip to Grosse Île, Quebec City, Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Shrine, and Montreal from September 12<sup>th</sup>\_14<sup>th</sup>, 2014. We've obtained very reasonable prices for the bus, hotels, and island tour. Our current estimate of the per-person cost is \$250 to \$260 for the three-day trip. In order to ease the financial burden on everyone, we're offering a \$45 per-month installment plan from April to September. Six monthly payments may be easier for some than coming up with one lump sum payment in September. The bus has 56 seats. The hotels and island tour company are very flexible regarding our number, so if we fall short of 56 passengers, we will not be charged. I'm confident that we can fill the bus. AOH, Ladies AOH, CNY-ICS, and IACI members and their families and friends have first priority for seats on the bus. We'll expand to the general public if needed. I have to provide a final headcount and list of names for the hotels and island tour company as soon as possible, so that they can finalize our contracts. Please let me know by the Sunday, April 6<sup>th</sup> meeting if you plan to take the trip and provide the names of you, your spouse, partner, friends, and/or enemies who are coming with you. Call me at (315) 727-7048 or email [aohsteve@gmail.com] to reserve your spot. Also, let me know if you are choosing the monthly payment plan or the lump sum option. Please note that everyone must present a valid passport or NYS Enhanced Driver's License to enter Canada and return to the USA. The least expensive and quickest option is to obtain an Enhanced Driver's License (only \$30, but you must go to the DMV in person and show proof of citizenship). Checks can be sent to our Division's postal address, which is listed on the back of this newsletter.

Join me in welcoming our newest AOH Syracuse Division member — Peter Seitz! Let's continue to make progress toward achieving our 2014 membership goal of 300. Remember that many men would join if only you ask! AOH membership requirements and our Division's application are available on our website [www.syraoh.com].
