Worthy Brothers,

- ☑ I just returned from the AOH National Convention in Philadelphia, PA, where over 1,200 delegates converged to espouse our culture, religion, and freedom for Ireland. We listened to the Cardinal, the Mayor of the City, and two former Mayors of Belfast (SDLP's Alban McGinnis and Sinn Fein's Alex Maskey -- the only Catholics ever elected Mayors of Belfast). We also heard from the JFK Medal recipient Fr. Aidan Troy, the Pastor of Holy Cross School in Belfast. Fr. Troy spoke about the terrorizing of the 4- to 12-year-old girls who trudged the road to and from School each day with their mothers while under attack by grown men and women throwing urine-filled bottles, bricks, and petrol bombs. Fr. Troy, a Dubliner, had been working for the Vatican in Rome for 12 years when he was assigned to Belfast. He mentioned his shock at what he witnessed during that siege. The good Father could not believe that such hatred existed toward these little girls simply because they were Catholic -- in this day and age. We Hibernians presented him with a check for \$41,000 to assist the children in receiving help to overcome the trauma and keep the school going. This past January, Brothers Dan Case, Frank Corcoran, Geordy Austin, and I visited Holy Cross School and presented a \$2,000 check from our Division. If you ever saw the beautiful faces on these little girls, your heart would break from what our people have to endure in that Godforsaken, British-ruled, bigoted, stolen statelet.
- ☑ I am pleased to announce that our Division was awarded the Certificate of Merit at the AOH National Convention in honor our charitable donations over the past year. We had the highest donation total of all Divisions in the Northeastern U.S. (including NYC and Boston)!! Great work gentlemen.
- ☑ Of all the sites I've seen, none compare to the AN GORTA MOR Memorial at the seaport. I've never been so touched and moved by such an astonishing work commemorating our starved dead. This giant sculpture depicts a nervous mother with her son digging up the rotten spuds. Then it proceeds to show the vanquished dying on the roadways while some haggard souls ascend a gangplank to a ship, and the fewer yet who reach the port with worried and fear-filled faces, and a young lad looking with great anticipation on the new world. Truly a masterpiece. The name of the sponsor: "ANCIENT ORDER OF HIBERNIANS". Good for us.
