My four years as AOH Syracuse Division President have been lots of fun, and I'd like to thank all brothers for making it a great experience. Our division is the most active in upstate New York because of your efforts. You've accomplished great things and I'd like to mention a few big ones:

- Hurricane Sandy relief: Our casino night fundraiser resulted in the largest donation of any single division in the U.S. The hard-hit Irish-American communities in Brooklyn and Queens put the funds to use by feeding and clothing poor families in their communities.
- Old Newsboys: In the last four years, you've raised \$70,000 for the Christmas Bureau, which ensured that 28,000 children received toys for Christmas.
- AOH Historical Markers: Over the last two years, you've placed 12 AOH historical markers honoring the contribution of the Irish in Onondaga County.
- Commemoration of the centennial of the 1916 Easter Rising: This event was covered by television, radio, and print media, and brought Irish history to the attention of the general public.

Your continued support of Irish culture and religion as well as the movement to a United Ireland is vital, so keep up the good work!

The Old Newsboys Campaign will be held on Friday, December 9th and Saturday, December 10th. This great community fundraiser is sponsored by the United Way and the Salvation Army, and helps the Christmas Bureau provide gifts for Christmas and food and other items for local families. Last year, more than 7,000 children received toys and books. For years, our Division has raised more money than any other volunteer group.
