We voted to frame and donate it (stipulated by Judge Burke in his mom's name from our Division) to the NYS Irish Historical Museum in East Durham when we go there in May. Pat O'Grady (chairperson for the museum) had never heard of such a ribbon, but was very excited. We concluded with an Irish Dancer, Dylon Richardson, from the Johnston School of Irish Dance. Dillon has won gold, silver, and bronze medals in competition and Dylon's mom, Fiona, also gave us an interesting lesson in the history of Irish dance, costumes, and judging competitions.
