All Irish speakers, from beginner to fluent, are welcome to join them for casual Irish language practice and chatting. You don't need proficiency – just a desire to learn while having fun. The group plans to meet on the first Monday of each month at that location.

Our bus trip to Grosse Île, Quebec has been scheduled for Friday September 12th through Sunday September 14th. The three-day/twonight stay in the Province of Quebec will include visits to the Shrine of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré (the Patron Saint of Canada), a cruise on the St. Lawrence River, including a four-hour stop at Grosse-Île and the Irish Famine Memorial, Old Montréal restaurants and nightlife, and Sunday morning Mass at Montreal's Basilica of St. Patrick (built by Irish immigrants fleeing an Gorta Mór in 1847). The trip is open to spouses, family, and friends. The cost is only \$260 per-person and includes the bus, breakfast, and Grosse Île tour. Final payment is due by Wednesday, September $10^{\frac{th}{2}}$ and a monthly payment plan is available.
