At the June 5<sup>th</sup> meeting, we'll be voting on a potential dues increase of \$10, which would result in the following dues costs:

- \$50 for existing members age 59 and younger
- \$45 initial fee for new members age 60+

Any member who has a financial hardship is encouraged to contact the Division President to arrange assistance. Please come and vote! We'll also discuss changes in the format and date of the Christmas party.

Our commemoration of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Easter Rising on April 24<sup>th</sup> was well attended and received in the community. The M<sup>c</sup>Guire and Fahey families want the AOH to know how grateful they are for our ceremony honoring former Mayor James K. M<sup>c</sup>Guire. This was our most high-profile event in years, and was covered by WSYR, Time Warner Cable News, WCNY, and the Syracuse Post-Standard. WCNY followed-up with an episode of its program 'Insight', which featured a discussion with Judge Joe Fahey, Mary House of 'Friends of Irish Freedom', and Geordy Austin of the AOH Syracuse Division. Other guests included AOH members from the Utica and Broome County Divisions.

On April 30th, the Utica Area Irish Coalition held an Easter Rising 100th anniversary commemoration dinner. The keynote speaker was our own Geordy Austin. Congratulations and thanks go to Geordy for sharing Irish History and keeping alive the dream of a united Ireland throughout Central New York.

The next big event on our calendar is the Monday, May 30<sup>th</sup> Camillus Memorial Day Parade. Event details are included in this newsletter.

The AOH National Convention will take place from July  $11^{\frac{th}{t}}$  to  $14^{\frac{th}{t}}$  at Harrah's in Atlantic City, NJ. AOH Major Degrees will be offered at the convention. If you're interested in attending, please let me know as soon as possible.

We'll be looking for volunteers for the 75<sup>th</sup> Central New York Scottish Games & Celtic Festival, which will be held on Saturday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. It's a big fundraiser for us and an honor to be invited back as a food vendor. In addition to our food tent, we'll have a booth in the 'Clan Row', and we'll be leading the Parade of Clans as we did last year. 
