- $\ensuremath{\overline{}}$ On Saturday, March $12^{\frac{\text{th}}{\text{-}}}$, we'll meet at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception at 9:45 am for the pre-parade St. Patrick's Mass. Our Division will once again have the honor of leading the procession. Please wear khaki pants and your AOH jackets (or other green jackets), so that we look sharp. Officers, please wear suits-&ties and dark overcoats.
- ☑ The St. Patrick's Parade starts at Noon, and line-up will be at 11:45 am on Salina Street, in front of the Post-Standard building. Join us after the parade for refreshments and food at Aster Pub in Armory Square (formerly Small Plates and PJ Dorsey's). Food and free drink chips will be provided to members and guests.
- ☑ The Onondaga County Parks Department is hosting the 7th annual Irish Road Bowling Tournament on Sunday, March 13th. An Irish buffet and beverages will be provided at the finish line. Here's information on two events that we're planning in commemoration of the 100^{th} anniversary of the Easter Rising: \square A brunch will be held at Kitty Hoynes on Sunday, April 24^{th} - the date

- on which the Rising began. This event will run from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm, is open to family and friends, and will include food, drinks, and music - for just \$10 per person. The brunch will be preceded by a visit to St. Agnes Cemetery for a reading at James K. M^cGuire's gravesite by Judge Joe Fahey of the Easter Proclamation (i.e., the Irish Declaration of Independence). Mayor M^cGuire was known as the "Boy Mayor" of Syracuse and was an active supporter of the Rising through his involvement in Clan-na-Gael, the Irish Republican Brotherhood, and the Irish Republican Army. He was also
- instrumental in bringing Eamon De Valera to Syracuse in 1919. ☑ On Saturday, August 27th, we'll have a memorial mass for the Easter Proclamation's signatories who were executed, a public reading of the Proclamation, and a summer picnic for members, families, and guests at Ryder Park, which is adjacent to the DeWitt Town Hall. The picnic will include food, drinks, and music.
