Worthy Brothers Dan Case and Frank Corcoran, with hats in hand, collected another \$300 from the guests assembled to hear Gerry Adams. A check was made to the Friends of Sinn Fein for a total of \$800 and was given to Mr. Downs, the Chairman of Friends. Many commented on the fact that Eamon DeValera was here in Syracuse in 1919 while a wanted man (or "terrorist") by the British Government as a result of his escape from prison in England. The escape was orchestrated by Michael Collins, the head of the IRA at the time. DeValera was President of the outlawed Republic of Ireland and was here raising money for the war effort. Thank God Ireland at this time is not at war. Unfortunately, the Dublin and British governments have failed miserably at enacting the Good Friday Agreement that was voted for overwhelmingly by both Protestants and Catholics. It was also fitting that Mr. Adams spoke at the old Post Office which was the scene of the 1916 Uprising where Padraig Pearse read the "Proclamation". Mr. Adams eloquently spoke about the need for all of us to do our part in whatever small way we can to bring about human rights, equality, and justice for all people in Ireland. I received a letter of thanks from Mr. Adams stating that it was the best St. Patrick's Day he has ever had. Many people have started to show an interest in reading about the troubles, and some have called or written their Senators and Representatives urging action on the situation, so good for us.


