I look forward to seeing and marching with many of you at the Camillus Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May $26^{\frac{th}{th}}$ (beginning at 9:30 am). We usually gather around 8:00 am. Please wear AOH apparel and khaki pants. Further details will be provided at our May $6^{\frac{th}{th}}$ meeting.

Our brothers and sisters in Rochester are hosting this year's state convention July $17^{\frac{th}{2}} - 20^{\frac{th}{2}}$, and I encourage you to attend and support. If you are interested in awakening "a pride in the ancient race of our forefathers and developing an interest in the history and destiny of that race", they plan to have a Degree Team who will administer the exemplification program. Major degrees are required for service as President or Vice President of the division.

There is a proposed motion to increase the AOH Syracuse Division 2 Catholic School Scholarship Award from \$500/student to \$750/student. The vote on the award increase will take place at the May meeting. Jim Sheridan provided the following information concerning the current scholarship and award process:

- ☑ Award \$500 scholarships to help defray the cost of tuition at Bishop Ludden/Bishop Grimes and Christian Brothers Academy schools in Central New York.
 - Applicants will apply for a scholarship through the school in the spring of grades 8, 9, 10, or 11.
- Scholarship winners are to be chosen by existing scholarship committees at the schools, based on the following criteria:
 - Attending (or will be) Bishop Ludden/Bishop Grimes or Christian Brothers Academy school.
 - Be a practicing Catholic.
 - Be of Irish descent from either parent.
 - The applying student shall write a brief essay describing how attending a Catholic school helps them foster the AOH motto of 'Friendship, Unity, and Christian Charity' in their life.
 - This essay should be submitted to the school's scholarship committee.
 - This essay would not be 'graded'. Completion and submission of an essay meets this requirement.
 - Once an awardee is chosen, and the school provides the AOH with the name of the student, along with a copy of their essay, money will be paid directly to the school to be applied to the awardee's tuition bill for the following fall.
- ☑ All things being equal between candidates, financial need (as known by the school only) should be the tie breaker.

The "300 Raffle" was a huge success last year – inspired and overseen by Tom, and we can raise a lot of money and share with lucky winners again this year!
