The Easter Rising Commemoration will occur on April 26th at 11 am at Syracuse City Hall. Members should have received an email encouraging your attendance. The date will not allow a report on the attendees and specifics, but those will be in next months newsletter.

The next big event will be the Camillus Memorial Day Parade on May 25th. We will gather at 8:30 am at the parking lot in the parking lot of the former TK Tavern (5600 Newport Rd.). Uniform will be as always – tan pants and AOH golf shirt or windbreaker or jacket, depending on the weather. There will be post-parade refreshments.
