



## **Kevin Hall Receives Endorsement of Madison County Democratic Party for State Senate**

GLEN CARBON, Illinois (Jan. 29, 2026) —Candidate for Illinois State Senate 56 and former Edwardsville Township Supervisor Kevin Hall received the official endorsement of the Madison County Democratic Party for the 2026 Primary Election last month. Hall has also received the support of the last five chairs of the county's Democratic Party, they are current Chairman Andy Asadorian, Dean Webb, Debbie Ming-Mendoza, Randy Harris, and Mark Von Nida.

"Kevin knows what it is like for working families during tough economic times, he knows that families are in positions to have difficult conversations about which bill gets paid or held," said Madison County Democratic Party Chairman Andy Asadorian. "He wants to fight for everyone, so that as wages increase, costs of living decrease. I'm proud to support him in his efforts to do so."

Hall is a current Edwardsville Township Democratic Precinct Committeeperson. His top priority in this campaign is to help people struggling in our community, from recently laid off Alton Steel employees to a single mother struggling to make ends meet. He is focused on addressing the rising cost of housing, groceries, childcare, utilities, and medical costs.

As Township Supervisor, Hall made helping people and improving the community his mission. He expanded support and funding for critical local programs, including Main Street's Meals on Wheels, GlenEd Food Pantry, Brown Bag Buddies, Overnight Warming Locations, and Back-to-School backpack drives.

He also led new efforts to address loneliness, isolation, and mental health by launching free Soup Socials and open gym programs. To support young families, Hall's administration created a diaper bank and implemented twelve weeks of paid parental leave for Township employees.

All of this was accomplished on a tight budget which allowed his final tax levy as Supervisor to be the lowest tax rate for Edwardsville Township in over 30 years.

Early voting for the 2026 Democratic Primary starts February 5th and Primary Election Day is Tuesday, March 17th.
