Job Description: Clinical Supervisee (Associate Counselor / Intern Therapist)

Job Title: Clinical Supervisee (Associate Counselor / Intern Therapist) Reports To: Clinical Supervisor / Clinical Director

Job Summary:

The Clinical Supervisee provides counseling and mental health services to clients under the supervision of a licensed clinical supervisor. This role is designed for provisionally licensed or associate-level counselors who are completing supervised practice hours toward independent licensure. The supervisee is responsible for delivering high-quality, ethical, and client-centered care while developing clinical skills and professional identity.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

Provide individual, group, couples, and/or family therapy under direct supervision.

Conduct client intake assessments, develop treatment plans, and document progress.

Maintain accurate and timely clinical records in accordance with agency and state requirements.

Participate in weekly supervision with assigned clinical supervisor.

Consult with supervisor regarding high-risk, ethical, or complex cases.

Apply evidence-based interventions while maintaining professional boundaries.

Uphold client confidentiality in compliance with HIPAA and state regulations.

Engage in professional development activities, including training and continuing education.

Collaborate with colleagues, community providers, and supervisors to support client care.

Qualifications:

Master's degree (or current enrollment in final year of graduate program) in counseling, social work, psychology, or related mental health field.

Current associate or provisional license (e.g., LAC, LMSW, AMFT) OR eligibility for such credential.

Strong interpersonal, organizational, and communication skills.

Commitment to ethical practice and professional growth.

Ability to accept feedback, reflect on practice, and integrate supervision into client care.

Work Environment:

Clinical office or private practice setting.

Supervision provided weekly in compliance with state board requirements.

Client caseload assigned in accordance with experience and training level.
