

Enrichment Enrollment (EE)

Qualified students who are not enrolled in Light House Academy are invited to participate in scheduled Real Life Experience trips provided throughout the year.

Requirements:

1. To qualify for participation in the EE program, students/families must first submit an LHA General Application for review.
2. Upon acceptance, LHA must have a current Emergency Information sheet on file before the student can travel with the school.
3. Upon acceptance, participating students are encouraged to attend all the monthly educational field trips. Independently completing any RLE materials provided (see below) will further enhance their experience.
4. The EE program fee of **\$200/school year** enrolls the first child in a family. Each additional child is \$50/student/school year.
5. Students-must meet dress code requirements for the field trip: red LHA polo OR casual clothes OR other assigned/appropriate clothing. Hiking dress code is: red LHA polo with logo or red PE t-shirt, pants (not shorts) including sweatpants, jeans, or regular dress code pants, shoes/boots that can get muddy, and coat/jacket as appropriate.

Program Details:

1. The RLE class coordinator will communicate the details of the field trip to Enrichment Enrollment families (i.e. date/time/location, special requirements, additional costs, etc.).
2. Any additional charges for the field trip are the responsibility of the family, and due before or on the field trip day.
3. Parents transport students to LHA; LHA transports students to/from the field trip location. Volunteers may be requested to assist with transportation.
4. Participation confirmation is required by the RSVP date.
5. The RLE (Real Life Experiences) excursions are usually supplemented with in-class preparations. These special classes are taught during school hours, often providing knowledge and information leading up to the specific field trip. The student enrolled at LHA through the EE program will receive information taught in LHA RLE classes. Except by special invitation, EE students will not attend the actual classes held in the classroom.
6. Incentive-based field trips provided to LHA students throughout the year and are not included in the EE program.

Expectations:

1. EE students will follow the rules as directed by the LHA teachers/chaperones and personnel during field trips. If there is a problem with behavior, parents will be notified and students may be disqualified from future excursions.
2. Students are representing Light House Academy during the educational field trips; respectful language and communication with teachers and fellow students is expected.
