

HUMAN TRAFFICKING (Health Care Professionals -1hr)

In compliance with Florida Law Chapter 2019-152, this course has been derived to fulfill the legal obligation of Health Care Workers in the state of Florida regarding Human Trafficking. This course will convey the State of Florida's established requirements, training and expectations regarding the need for awareness to Human Trafficking. The course sequence of training topics comply with the requirements established in Chapter 2019-152:

- ❑ By January1, 2021, each licensee or certificate holder shall complete a board-approved, or department-approved if there is no board,
- ❑ 1-hour continuing education course on human trafficking.
- ❑ The course must address both sex trafficking and labor trafficking,
- ❑ And how to identify individuals who may be victims of human trafficking
- ❑ And how to report cases of human trafficking,
- ❑ And resources available to victims

Each office is required to have a posted Human Trafficking Sign that is visible to the public within every office. Discussion will convey:

- ❑ Required size of sign, font size of letters and placement
- ❑ Verbiage that is to be on each sign
- ❑ Contact numbers to notify authorities of potential victim both local and national

Present several Human Trafficking cases that I (Facilitator) was the lead detective and the victim was recovered safe and returned to family. Class discussion and feedback on:

- ❑ Means used to travel, disguise and keep from being caught
- ❑ Befriended by older female who introduces them to the suspect (pimp)
 - ❑ Most runaways are lured in by this process
 - ❑ This is a consistent pattern and present in most of cases
 - ❑ It parallels Eppsteins method of luring young girls

Discuss the difference and reasons of targeted young females in the United States versus young females of third world countries

- ❑ 60 Billion Dollar a year enterprise and growing
- ❑ Organized Crime / Cartels / Gangs
- ❑ Internet / World Wide Web main reason for large growth
