A motion to approve **Resolution 2023-02** which authorizes the city clerk to transfer funds from the Go Bond Water savings account to the Debt Service Fund checking account was made by Gerlach with a second by Frett. All ayes.

Reports:

Gerlach reported that the fire station needs a second new thermostat and he inquired if the signs for the department have come in yet. Dan will take care of both of these items. Gerlach also asked that when the snow is plowed in town, that the corners are rounded off on the streets.

Jebsen updated the council that the Delmar Development will be applying for another grant to get more shades up at the Depot.

Dan reported that there was a water leak at the county shed that was taken care of and he is in the process of having the fence repaired at the well house.
