Omicron Phi Zeta Chapter and Women of the Dove Foundation Champion of the Arts Book Scholarship

On January 16, 1920, Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated was founded on the campus of Howard University by five visionary women who dared to depart from the traditional coalitions for black women and sought to establish a new organization based on the precepts of Scholarship, Service, Sisterhood and Finer Womanhood.

In furtherance of the vision of the founders, Omicron Phi Zeta Chapter was chartered on March 26, 1994. Since its chartering almost over 32 years ago, Omicron Phi Zeta Chapter members have supported a variety of causes and organizations, in addition to the Sorority's national initiatives. Omicron Phi Zeta is an award-winning chapter for its commitment to Z-HOPE (Zetas Helping Other People Excel) projects, involvement with its youth auxiliary and Undergraduate Chapter, Xi Sigma at The George Washington University.

The Women of the Dove Foundation (WDF) is the 501(c)3 organization that partners with Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, Omicron Phi Zeta Chapter. WDF is dedicated to improving the quality of life for individuals and families in local, national, and global communities. Every year, the foundation sponsors events to raise funds for WDF scholarships and other charitable causes.

We are pleased to announce the 2026 *Champion of the Arts Book Scholarship*. This scholarship is being awarded to a student who aspires to pursue a career in the arts. In addition, the student must be graduating from a District of Columbia or Metropolitan area high school (see *Eligibility Criteria* for DC area breakdown) and enrolling in an institution of higher learning in the Fall 2026. The institution may include a college, university, or trade school. The scholarship awardee will be notified by May 01, 2026, of their selection to receive a scholarship. The award recipient or representative of the awardee must be available June 7, 2026, to attend the reception to accept the award.

THE SCHOLARSHIP

This book scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.00 to one (1) student graduating from high school and entering an accredited college or university or trade school during the Fall 2026 academic semester. Proof of attendance must be on the university/college letterhead, with your student identification number and the address to the financial aid department, must be received by email or postmarked by mail by August 22, 2026, to receive the disbursement.

ELIGIBILITY

Each applicant must:

- Be a resident of the DC Metropolitan area (to include Washington, D.C.; Alexandria, VA; Arlington County, VA; Fairfax County, VA; Falls Church, VA; Prince William County, VA and Prince Georges County, MD; Montgomery County, MD; or Charles County, MD);
- Pursue a major in arts, visual arts, fine arts, performing arts, creative writing, music, graphic design, or design;
- Be graduating from an accredited high school in the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan area at the end of the 2025-2026 academic school year; and
- Have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 or above at the time of application submission.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed typed, written (legible print) or computer-generated application form.
- 2. A 250-word essay on "Why do you want to pursue the arts in college?"
- 3. A current, official (sealed) copy of your high school transcript. An electronic unofficial transcript is also acceptable.
- 4. One sample of original artwork, recording of musical composition, creative writing sample, or video of a performance.
- 5. A 150 200-word bio.
- 6. Two (2) letters of recommendation. Recommendations can be obtained from a current or former teacher, guidance counselor, principal, pastor, employer, coach, or extracurricular activities director. *Please note that ALL recommendations must be received by the due date for your application package to be reviewed.*
- 7. Application Package Completion Checklist.

DEADLINE

- The application package is due on April 5, 2026, at 11:59 pm.
- Incomplete scholarship applications will not be considered. This includes ALL recommendations. Please ensure your recommendations are received prior to the due date. Please proofread your applications. Visit https://www.grammarly.com/ for assistance.
