- c. You are free to seek another opinion from another counselor/coach or terminate counseling/coaching at any time you choose.
- d. In a professional relationship, any sexual/harassing behavior (whether explicit or implicit) is never appropriate and should be reported to the board that regulates, registers, or licenses such unlicensed psychotherapist, registrant, or licensee (at the address, referenced above).

- e. The information provided by the client during therapy sessions is legally confidential in the case of unlicensed psychotherapists, except for certain legal exceptions that will be identified by the unlicensed psychotherapist should any such situation arise during the coaching session.
- f. Except in the case of information given to a licensed psychologist, legal confidentiality does not apply in criminal or delinquency proceedings.
- g. All information provided by the client during coaching sessions will remain strictly confidentially, except under the following conditions:
 - 1. I have your written permission.
 - 2. I believe it is necessary to prevent clear and imminent danger to you or others.
 - 3. You indicate there is reasonable cause to believe that a child or dependent adult has been abused.
 - 4. A court orders us to disclose confidential information about you.
 - If this happens, I will only disclose the minimum amount of information that I deem necessary to satisfy the court's order.

The information above must be provided to all clients according to Colorado Law. If you have questions about this information, please ask for clarification.
