BFC publishes Summary of Responses to the Draft Local Plan

Good afternoon Folks,

On Friday 6th March the BFC published the summary of our responses to the Consultation late last year on the Strategic Revised Growth Strategy.

The key issue in the document from all our point of view was the Proposal LP7 the Syngenta Site on Jealott's Hill.

The good news is that 363 residents responded to the consultation generating almost 2,900 comments and of the residents responding 99% were opposed to the proposal.

Please see <u>attached</u> which includes a link to the Summary of Responses but if you objected then you should have received a notification from BFC already. If you did not then it may be that your objections were not received or tracked or recognised. In any case you should look at the attached for what to do next.

In summary, if you did submit a response in December then we need you to do something else now and only have until 20th March to do it. To help you the <u>attached</u> gives you all the details you need and a pre-prepared text of the two emails we have drafted and you will reply to the council using one of these. Response must be by email and the address for the emails is on the attached.

We want you to copy your BFC Councillors and your MP. You can find the email addresses of Councillors and the ward they represent on the BFC Website via the link https://democratic.bracknell-forest.gov.uk/mgMemberIndex.aspx?bcr=1 and the MPs emails on www.parliament.uk.

The time for responding is tight and closes on 20th March so as the new working week beckons maybe you could find 15 minutes or so send a response because the more they receive the stronger is our case. We will have further consultation opportunities and we will keep you informed by email and via our brand spanking new Campaign website which should launch over this weekend but more on that later.
