'But I'm A Virgin'

Project Summary

Genre: Dark Comedy/Disaster/Coming of Age.

Pitch: "Don't Look Up" meets "The 40-Year-Old-Virgin".

Logline: With just under 12 hours until an asteroid strikes earth, a reserved and insecure 24-year-old who struggles with her faith embarks on an uproarious journey to lose her virginity before it's too late.

Story: KELLEN (24) begins the day by attending a grueling Catholic confessional followed by a marriage proposal from her adult altar boy boyfriend JACK (26). After arriving at her workplace where she takes customer calls for malfunctioning vacuums, she is bullied by her coworker BOWIE (22) and belittled by her boss CAMI (31). Later, news breaks that an asteroid will destroy the planet in less than 12 hours.

After trekking across the city for Jack only to find him with another woman, Kellen dumps him and decides to go on a prurient journey of losing her virginity. With the help of her sex-positive roommate AMES (25), they attend a lavish end-of-the-world party but end up getting chased out by two women in purge-like costumes (one of the women is Cami). Kellen and Ames flee to their cosplaying neighbor's house BURT (35) where he provides shelter in a pillow fort complete with a chest of "fake" weapons. With Cami in the mix, she mistakenly grabs a "fake" grenade, and blows up the house causing Burt and Ames to leave Kellen to fend for herself.

After tacking up posters around town advertising her virginity, Kellen returns home just as her house is obliterated by an asteroid chunk. A dark suitor named ASMODEUS (late 20's) waits by and shoves her into his van. He reveals that he is the leader of a cult named "God's Little Bastards". Kellen escapes the cult and finds shelter in an empty house where she finds Bowie hiding out as well.

She realizes Bowie is a suitor and follows him to the grocery store where they encounter CAMDEN (13) and his group of lost boys who want Kellen for themselves. After they dodge the lost boys, Kellen confesses she is a virgin and makes a move on Bowie who politely rejects her. Meanwhile, Jack gets in touch with Kellen's father NOAH (42) and lures him to the city after assuming she perished in her house fire.

Kellen makes it back to her burning house only to be shoved into Noah's van. Bowie and the cult follow as the van flees the city. After arriving home, Jack announces a wedding will be had in the bunker before the impact. Kellen is forced into an old wedding dress but escapes with Bowie before the wedding. They end up lost in a field and are met face-to-face with the cult. As an asteroid chunk hits the field and sets the dry grass aflame creating a fire circle around Bowie and Kellen, Jack charges through the fire with Asmodeus's dagger toward Bowie until his hand is severed off from an asteroid chunk.

Bowie and Kellen finally have sex as the asteroid approaches. Kellen watches it get closer and notices it passes peacefully just as Bowie finishes. The next morning Kellen and Bowie purchase Plan B at a local pharmacy. Bowie is short money so Kellen gives the clerk her purity ring. It is accepted and she is given the box of Plan B. The world lives on.

Characters (suggested cast):

Kellen: Longs to be free from purity. She struggles with her faith and sexuality. (Jaz Sinclair)

Jack: Narcissistic adult altar boy obsessed with the idea of marriage. (Tom Rhys)

Noah: Conservative, doomsday prepper, and controlling father of Kellen. (Taye Diggs)

Cami: Maniacally angry and depressed boss of Kellen. Violent in every way. (Colby Minifie)

Bowie: Means well but is misunderstood. Confused on his feelings for Kellen. (Nico Hiraga)

Ames: Sex positive, bubbly, eccentric, and encouraging of all humans. (Renee Rapp)

Burt: Professional cosplayer with a knack for danger and "fake" weapons. (Mark Fishbach)

Asmodeus: Well-spoken yet amateurish "God's Little Bastards" cult leader. (Caleb Landry Jones)

Camden: Horny and obsessive pre-teen. Dangerous? He likes to think so. (Mason Thames)
